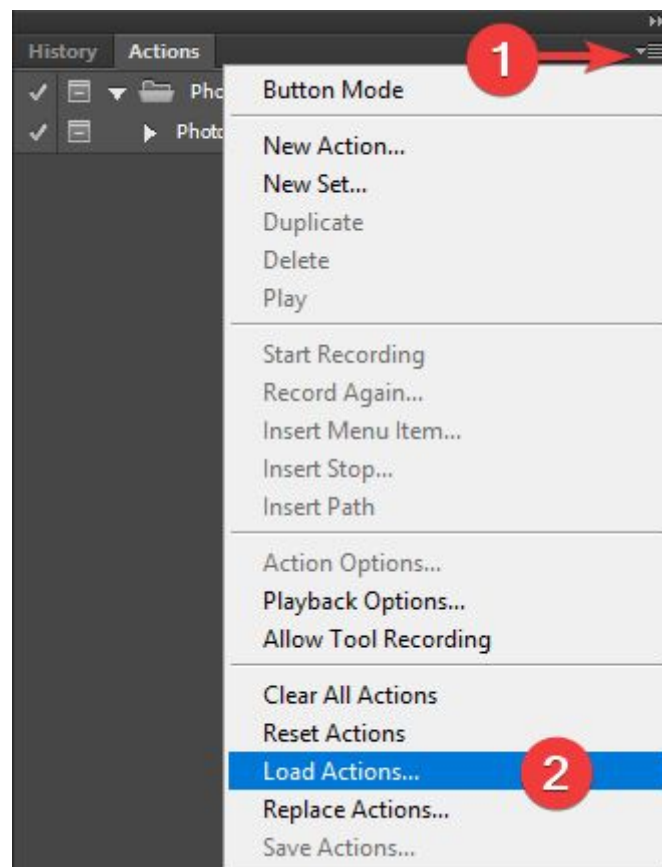

Installation

Installing Action

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Actions'. A window will now appear to the right hand side.
2. Inside the Actions window, click on the top right hand corner icon to reveal the drop down menu. From here select 'Load Actions.'. Select 'Action.atn' which came with the download.
3. The action will now appear in the actions panel.



OR drag and drop, **OR** double click

Installing Brush and Patterns

1. Open folder where your Photoshop was installed (usually it installed on drive C:\Program Files\Adobe\Photoshop), and copy files which came with the download to the corresponding folders .

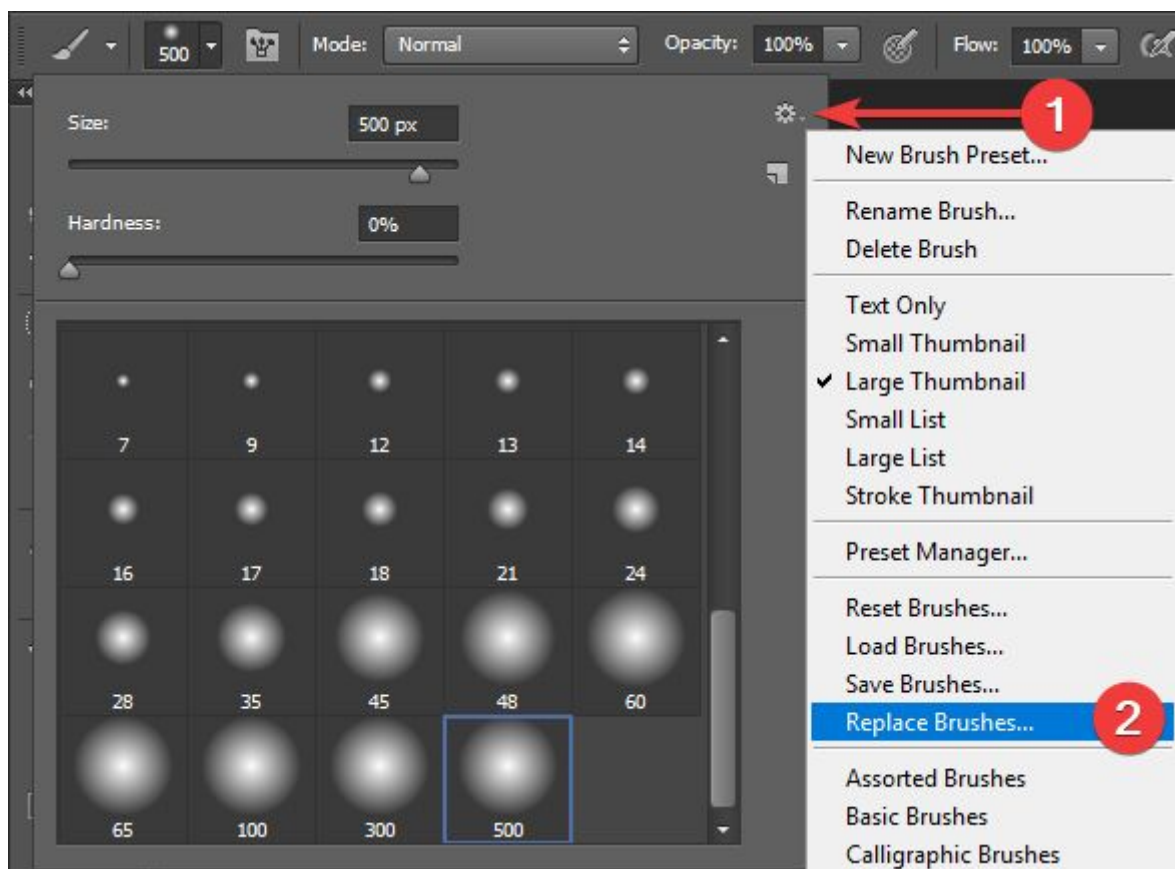
2. Copy 'Brush.abr' to C:\Program Files\Adobe\Photoshop (your version)\Presets\Brushes

If action has patterns

Copy 'Pattern.pat' to C:\Program Files\Adobe\Photoshop (your version)\Presets\Patterns

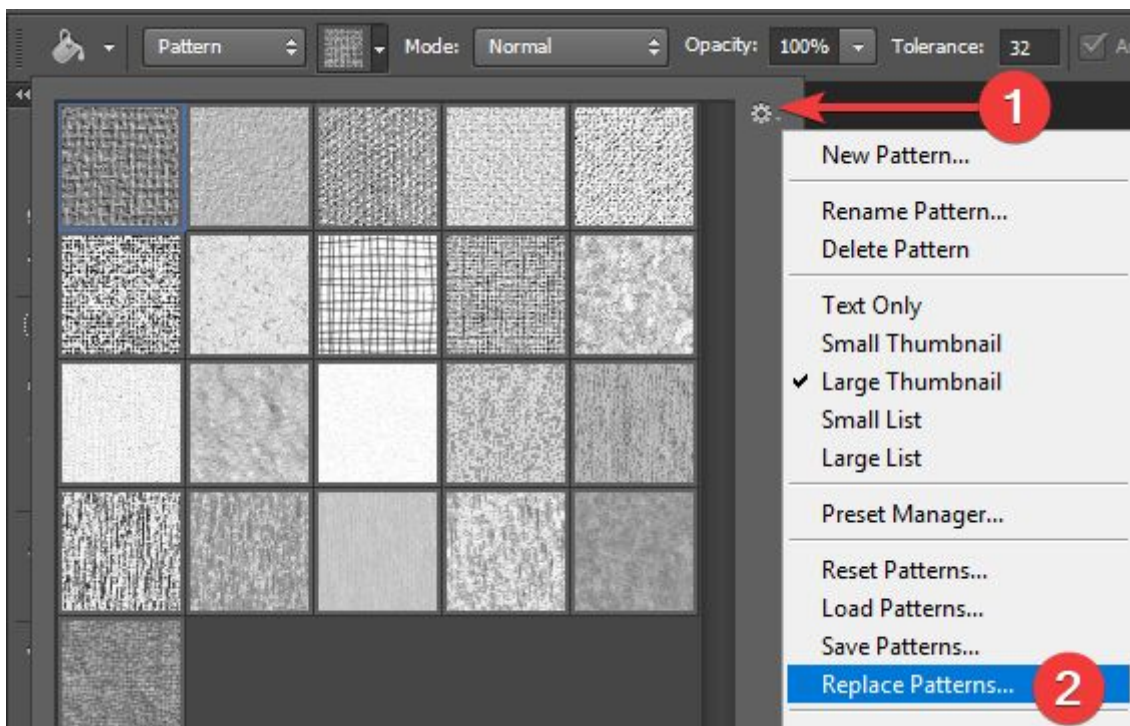
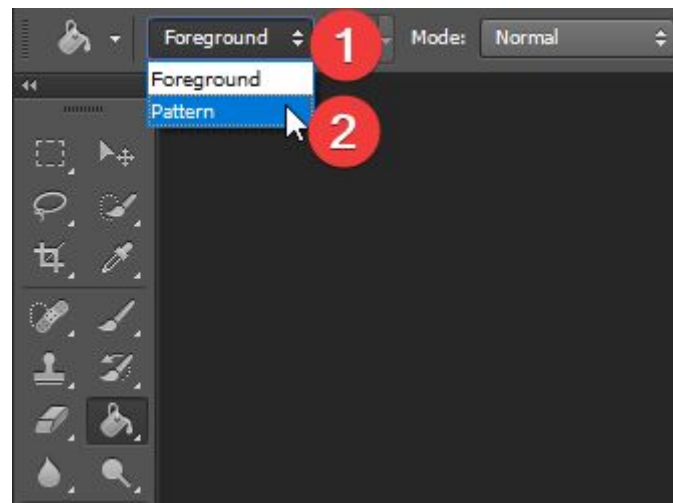
OR

Select **Brush Tool** pop-up menu (cogwheel icon), replace active brushes



OR drag and drop, **OR** double click

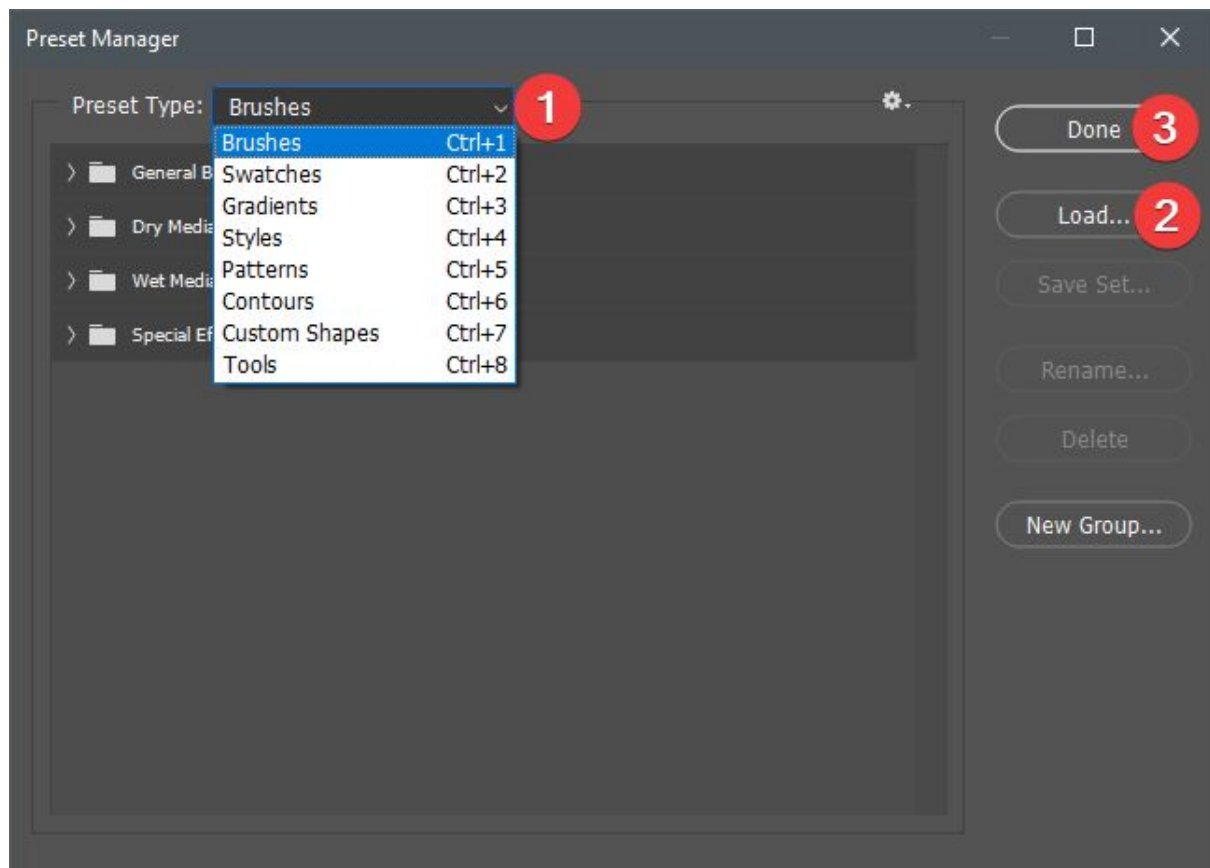
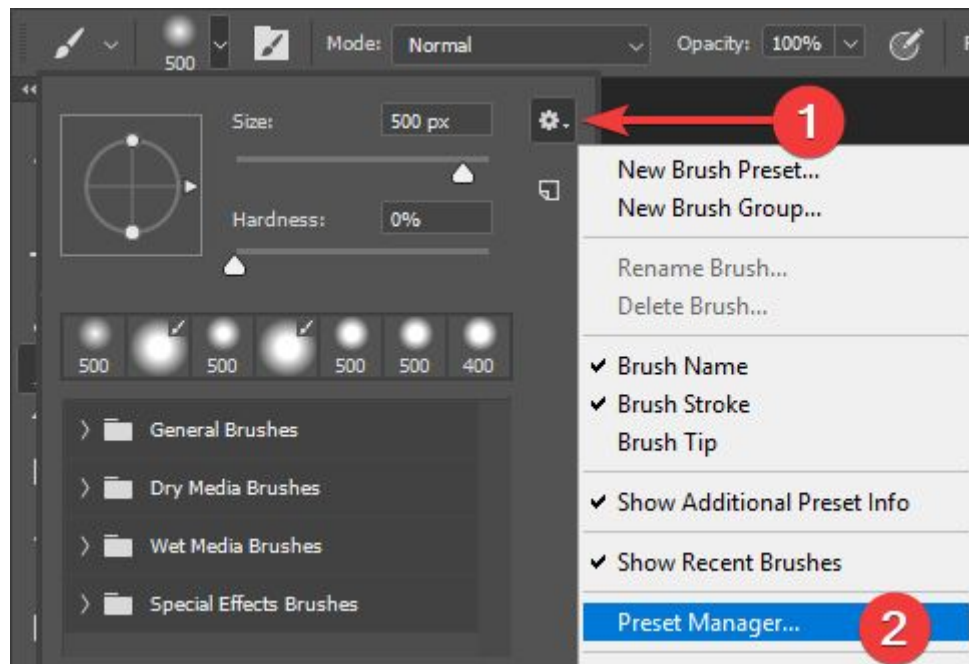
If action has **Patterns...** Select **Paint Bucket tool** - Foreground/Patterns menu (cogwheel icon), replace active patterns



OR drag and drop, **OR** double click

OR you can use **Preset Manager** – Edit > Presets > Preset Manager

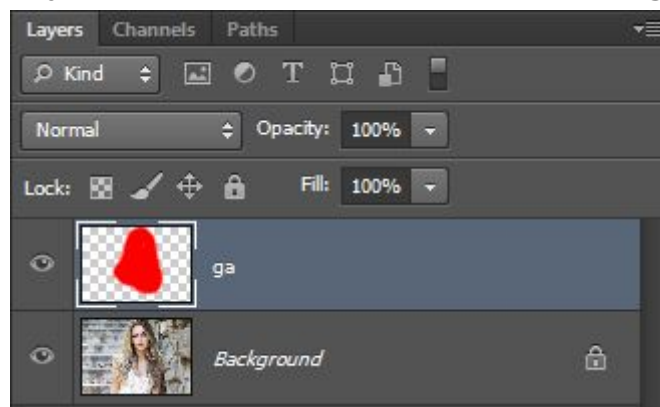
(you can find Preset Manager in Brush Tool pop-up menu and in Paint Bucket tool - Foreground/Patterns menu)



How to use

1. Open or load 'Brush.abr' file (Brush Tool pop-up menu)
Important ! Brush tool must be 100% opacity and 100% Flow
2. Open a photo to work with.
3. Leave the photo layer locked and set as the 'Background'.
4. Create a new layer above the background layer called 'ga'.
5. With the 'ga' layer selected, brush onto the areas of your photo that you want to apply the effect to. Try to brush closer to the centre of the image.



6. Now select the action and hit the play button found at the bottom of the action panel.
