

How to setup the action.

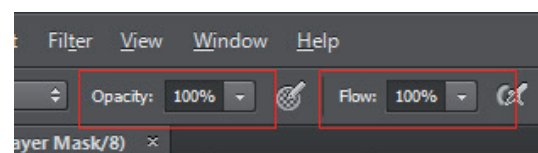
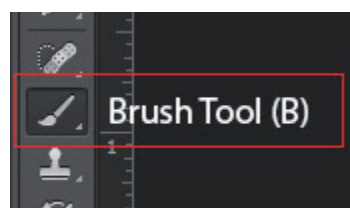
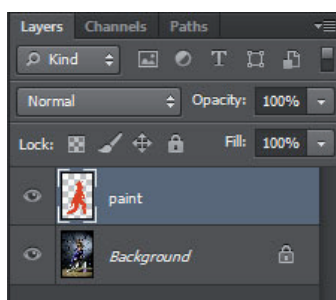
1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Actions'.
A window will appear to the right hand side panel (beside layer panel).
2. Inside the Actions window panel, click on the top right hand corner icon, select 'Load Actions...'. Choose the action (.atn) from the download directory.
3. The action will now appear in the actions panel.
4. Setup **the brush**, select brush icon, go to top, below "**Edit**", click on brush preset picker, at top right hand corner icon to show drop down list, select "Preset Manager", at the "**Preset Type**" choose "**Brushes**", click "Load...". Choose the brush (.abr) from the download directory.

How to use the action?

1. Open a photo.
2. Your image is in RGB color mode and 8bits/Channel color mode.
3. Please use 300dpi image size pixel resolution around range 2000px (width) to 3000px (width) in proportion.
4. This action only run in **english** version of Photoshop. If you are not using the English version of Photoshop, you can always change it to English and then back again to your native language using this method below.

go to Edit / Preferences / interface / UI Language: English

5. Leave the photo layer as the 'Background'. If your photo is not the Background, go to the menu 'Layer' 'New'--> 'Layer from Background..'. Please refer to the video tutorial if you need more help here.
6. Create a new layer above background layer and name it '**paint**'. All text must be in lowercase.
7. With the '**paint**' layer selected, paint the areas of your photo that you want to apply the effect.
8. Before click on play button, please make sure the paint layer and brush tool is selected, opacity is 100% and flow is 100%,



9. Now "PRESS" the play button found at the bottom of the action panel. This action will run few minutes depend on your cpu performance. After action done, please see video demo for layer customization.
