

Our Lightroom Presets are specifically designed to create a certain tone and style with your images. With the new Adobe Photoshop Lightroom *Creative Cloud* Membership, editing photos on your computer, smartphone, or tablet updates automatically update across all devices.

Due to the nature of the wide variety on individual shooting styles, camera types and camera settings, these presets will behave differently on different photos. Use the presets as a starting point, exposure, saturation, shadows, tone or highlights may need to be adjusted to achieve the best output.

INSTALL LIGHTROOM PRESETS ON YOUR DESKTOP COMPUTER



(Lightroom CC is the *new* cloud based Lightroom that will sync with the mobile app on your phone. Presets will also work with Lightroom Classic CC. I use both.)

*Please note: you must UPDATE all Lightroom and Camera Raw Programs first. All presets will be converted to the new .xmp filetype.



1. **Download Persnickety Desktop Preset Pack**
2. **Open Lightroom CC**
3. **Follow instructions below to import presets**

Lightroom CC: This lightroom version is for the user who wants to edit on both desktop and mobile using their Adobe *Creative Cloud* Membership. \$9.99 / mo. Lightroom 6 is the last standalone version of Lightroom.




1. Install *Lightroom CC* on your Desktop computer, presets will *automatically sync seamlessly* to the Lightroom mobile app. Open the preset panel by clicking PRESETS on the bottom right > click the 3 dots on the top of the panel > click import presets > browse to download and install.
