## PERSNICKETY LIGHTROOM MOBILE PRESETS

(released October 2018)

Our Lightroom Presets are specifically designed to create a certain tone and style with your mobile and professional images. With the new Adobe Photoshop Lightroom *Creative Cloud* Membership, editing photos on your computer, smartphone, or tablet updates automatically update across all devices.



Due to the nature of the wide variety on individual shooting styles, camera types and camera settings, these presets will behave differently on different photos. Use the presets as a *starting point*, exposure, saturation, shadows, tone or highlights may need to be adjusted to achieve the best output.

## HOW TO INSTALL PRESETS ON YOUR MOBILE PHONE OR TABLET


Mobile presets are easy to install for Adobe *Creative Cloud* users. If you are an Adobe *Creative Cloud* Member (\$9.99 monthly subscription) download the desktop presets and follow instructions. Presets will sync automatically to your mobile device.

\*Please note: you must UPDATE all Lightroom and Camera Raw Programs first. All presets will be converted to the new .xmp filetype.

## FREE LIGHTROOM MOBILE APP PRESET INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS (NON CREATIVE CLOUD SUBSCRIBERS )

**Good News:** The Lightroom CC Mobile App is FREE!

**Bad News:** It's a bit more complicated installing presets in the mobile app, but still possible. Stay with me! If you're an Adobe *Creative Cloud* Member, please see the desktop instructions for a simple cloud sync install.




## 1. Install the Free Lightroom App


## 2. Open Lightroom .DNG images on your phone

These are the presets you downloaded from Persnickety Prints. They'll essentially be images in a .DNG format embedded with the preset that you'll install and save in your lightroom app. Different phone settings and software may show the .DNG file differently.


We will install each preset one at a time.

**What is a .DNG?** Adobe Digital Negative *Raw Image file*


## 3. Click on the first .dng preset.



#### 4. Click Download




#### 5. Click "Open in Lightroom CC"




## 4. Open Presets

Your Lightroom CC App should open and you'll then see the preset image. Now we will add and save the presets.



## 5. Create New Preset Group

(You'll do this step once. This preset group will be the folder that holds the presets you're installing today)



## 6. Name and Save Preset

Find the Preset Group in the Drop Down. Add Preset Name. Click the ✓ in the top right to save.

**Repeat this step with each preset until they are all installed.**
