



How to Edit Logo Templates



All vectors in my resource sets are fully scalable, meaning they will retain their crisp quality no matter how big or small you make them. This guide will help you get the most out of these logo templates. Happy creating!

VECTOR LOGOS are the best option for your business if you plan to use them anywhere other than online.. If you want your logo printed on stationary, posters or textiles, you will want to use these vectors rather than a .png. To change the text you will need Adobe Illustrator (.ai files) or Adobe Photoshop (.psd files). The .eps file works in both Illustrator and Photoshop. (Please note, editing text in Photoshop means that it will not be a vector and might not scale up to bigger sizes. I always recommend using Illustrator or equivalent vector software where possible.)

Select the Type Tool (the symbol with a T in your tool bar, or press the letter T on your keyboard if you have shortcuts turned on).

Hover your cursor over the placeholder text that I put in the logo. You should now be able to click into that text, select it, delete it, and type your own text.

You can also change the colours as you would any text or shape.

To make a vector bigger or smaller and retain its dimensions, a handy tip is to hold down SHIFT while you drag one corner of the logo's bounding box. The vector should retain its proportions.
