SAVING AS PDF FOR COMMERCIAL PRINTING IN MICROSOFT PUBLISHER (300 DPI , CMYK COLORS)

If you will be sending this file to be printed at a Commercial Printing Shop. You will need to save it properly so that publisher can set the correct resolution of 300 dpi and also the correct color mode (CMYK).

Go > File > Save As

Choose: PDF

When the dialog box appears, Choose Options, under Optimize for Section

Another Dialog Box will open.

Choose: Commercial Press ( under Specify how this publication will be printed or distributed)

Click OK to finish with this section

Click Save to save the PDF File

You can also try a PDF Printer App which produces a better (more stable) pdf file

Doro PDF Writer installs a virtual printer on your system with which you can create PDF documents for free from any Windows app

After you install Doro pdf, you can open the Publisher file and Go > File > Print and choose Doro PDF as the printer. Follow the prompts to print the .pdf file to your desktop.

Each Page Must be Saved Separately

Choose The Page You Want to Save - Click on it in The Pages Section to The Left

Choose - Tagged Image File Format

Click Change by The Resolution Option that Appears

Choose - High quality printing or commercial press (300 dpi) - from the Pick Resolution dialog box that appear

Click Ok

Click Save to Save The .Tiff File

The pages are setup in Printer Spreads Format. So even though the pages are on the same Spread, they are not meant to be consecutive when printed.

The 8 pages printer spread diagram shows where each page should be.

Each spread is meant to back up the other, making the pages fall in the correct sequence when printed and folded.
