4. use English versions of Photoshop CS4,CS5,CS6,CC2014,CC2015,CC2017,2018.

Uploading :

1 Open "Adobe Photoshop" and click "File > Open"

2 You select "Fire Ignition Photoshop Action ATN " file

If you don't change "All Documents" of enable settings, you can't select. because, seems passive

Using :

Import any content white background image in to Photoshop.

Select your layer and click start action.

It's finished! Congratulations!

You can reach to actions from top view in "Window > Actions"

Fire Ignition Photoshop Action.

1. Go to File -> Open, choose your photo and click "Open".

2. Go to Layer -> New -> Layer

3. Take a "Brush Tool (B)" and brush the areas that you want to stay in

focus. Rename the layer to "brush" (Important: all letters must be lower case).

To do that, double click on layer name and type "brush".

4..Then again Go to Layer -> New -> Layer

5 .Take a "Brush Tool (B)" and brush the areas that you want to stay in focus. Rename the layer to

"area" (Important: all letters must be lower case). To do that, double click on layer name and type "area".

6. ATN File CompletelyMinimum: Photoshop CS5, Resolution: Doesn't MatterEasy to edit

and customize. Open "Adobe Photoshop" and click "File > open it and Play.For further

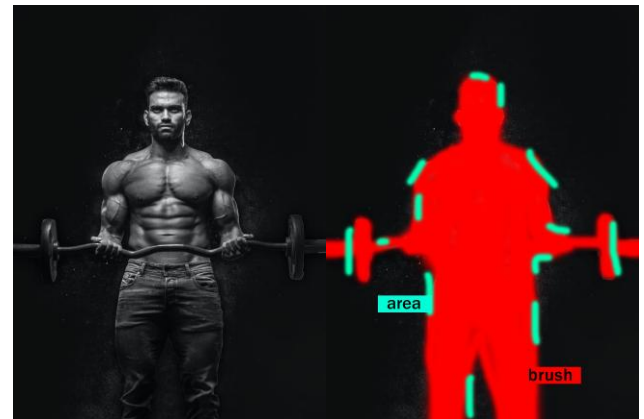
