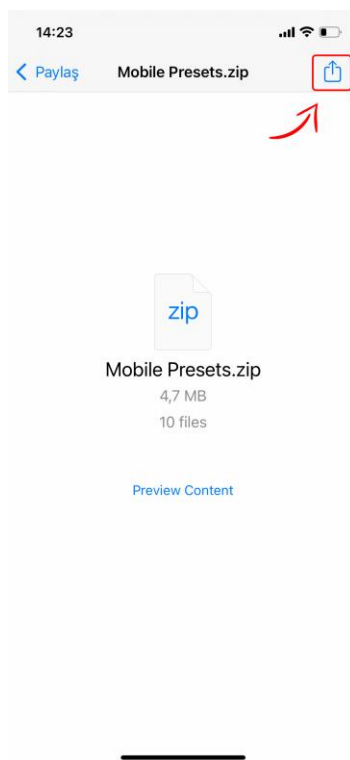


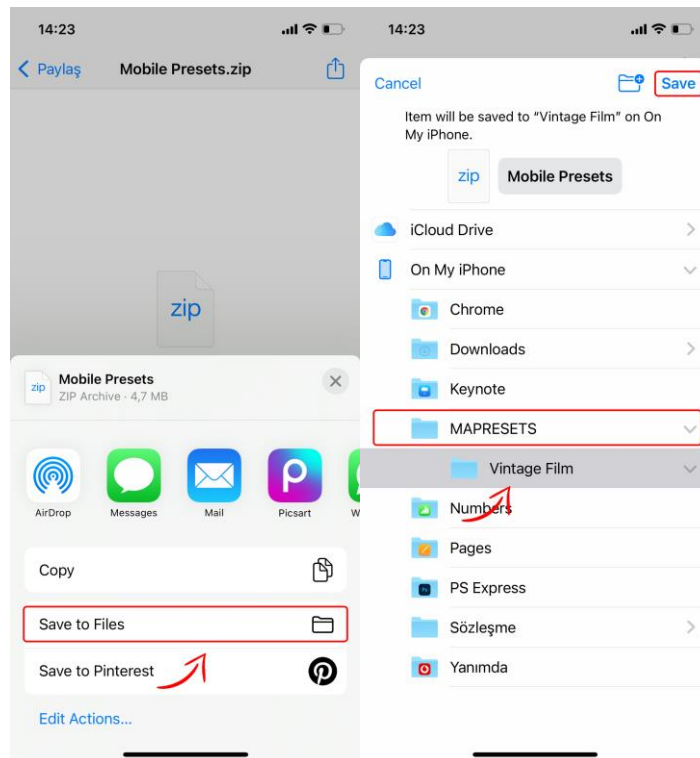

☆ How to Unzip a Zip File With Your iPhone or iPad's Files App ☆

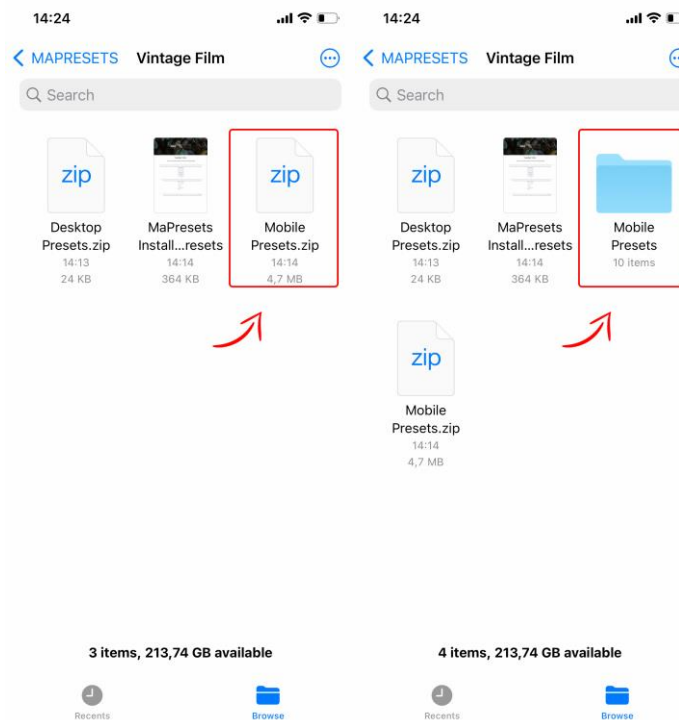
The Files app, added in iOS 11, supports zip files. You can open them, see their contents, and extract files without any third-party apps. You'll still need an app from the App Store if you want to create zip files.



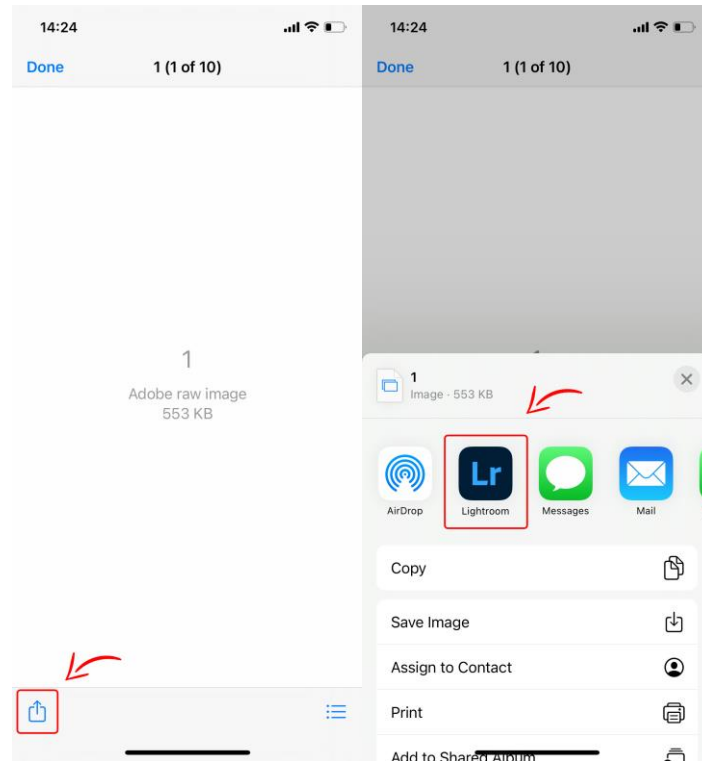
- When you download a zip file in Safari, your iPhone or iPad will offer to open it in the Files app. Tap “Open in Files” to do so. You can also save zip files to the Files app from other applications.



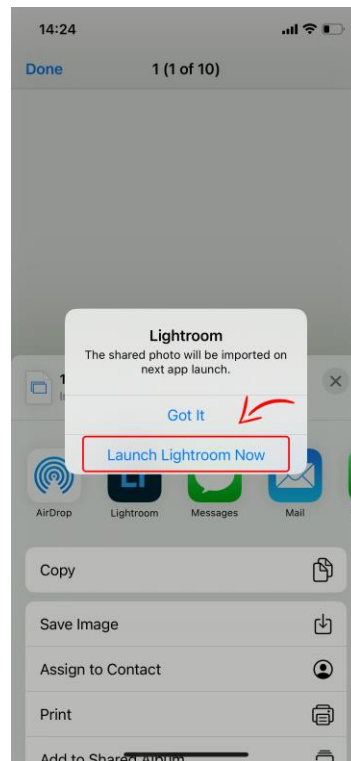
- You'll be prompted to choose a location for the zip file. You're saving a copy of the zip file to this location. Select a location—like your iCloud Drive or a folder on your iPhone—and tap “Add.”



- Tap the zip file in your Files app to open it.
- You can view the contents of the zip file here. If the zip file contains multiple files, swipe left and right



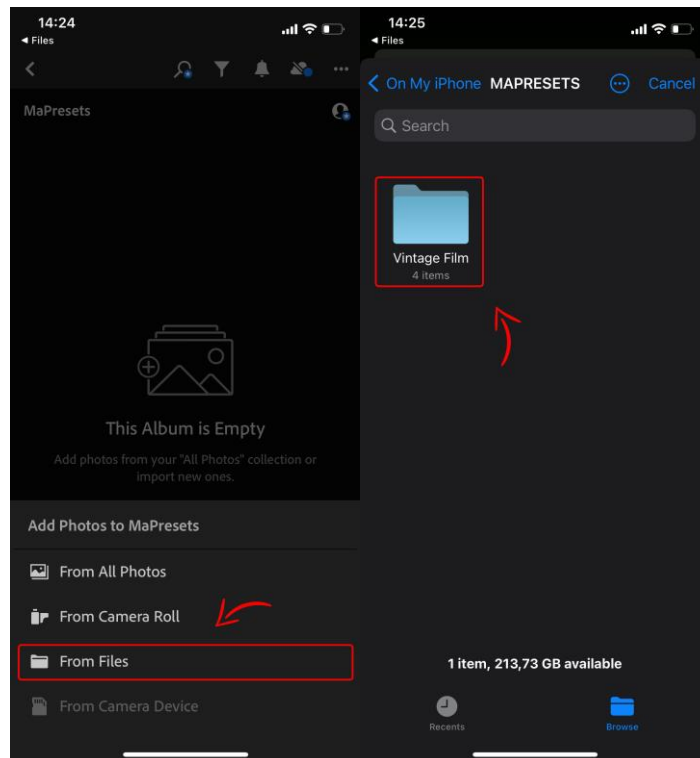
- To extract a file from the zip archive, tap the Share button and select “Save to Files” to save it to your files app, or tap an app to immediately send it to that app.



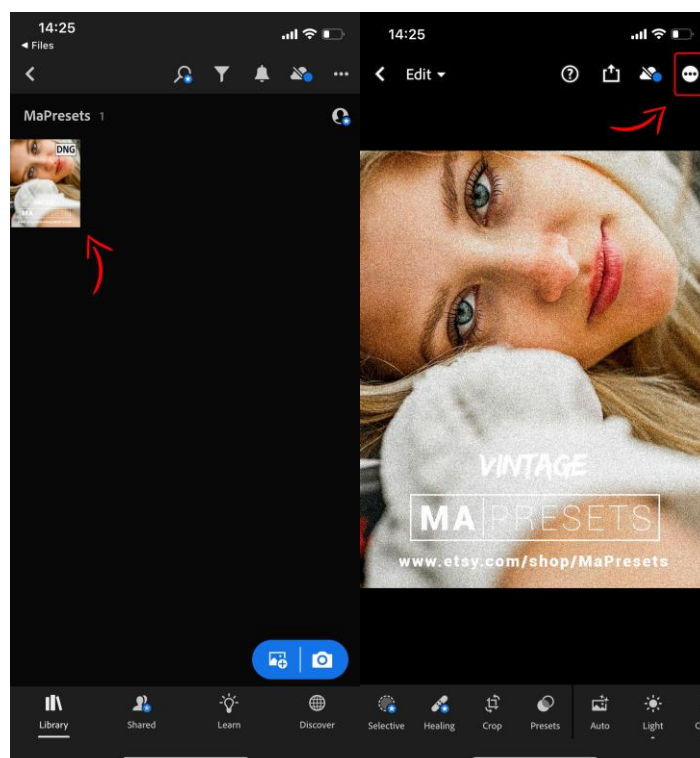
- Scroll through your apps to choose Lightroom CC as pictured left. Click “Copy to Lightroom CC”.

☆ How to Install on Lightroom Mobile iPhone and Android ☆

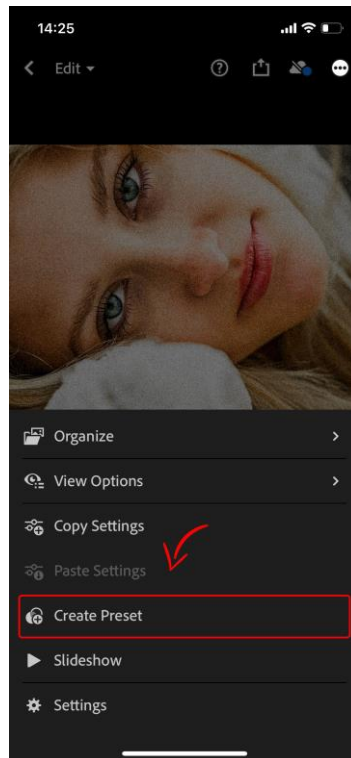
- Download the presets in **DNG** format.
- Open your Lightroom Mobile app and click the **image +** icon (next to the camera icon) at the bottom right to import the presets.
iPhone: Tap **From Files**.



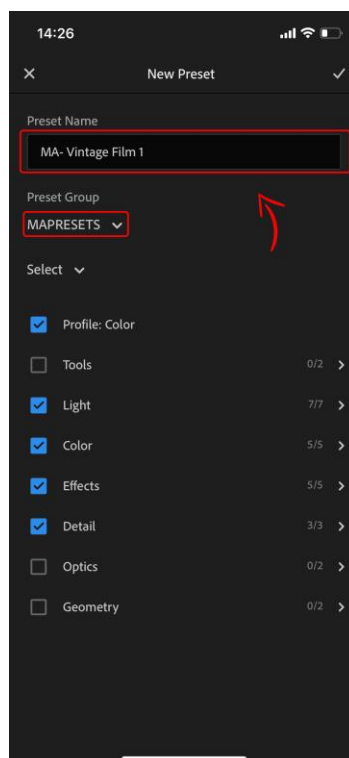
- Select the DNG preset you downloaded earlier to start importing to Lightroom.
Android: Tap the DNG file you downloaded to import it. It will have the **RAW** label on it.



- Tap the DNG file you imported. Click on the 3-dot (...) icon at the top right corner



- Select “**Create Preset**”. This will save the settings that you can use for all you photos.



- Name the preset. Select a folder to add the preset to or create a new one. Remember where you save it to so you can find the preset later on.



- Open the photo that you want to apply the preset to. Select **Presets** from the bottom tool slider



- Select the folder where you save the presets, then tap the preset to apply. 😊

☆ How To Install Lightroom 4, 5, 6 & CC 2017 Presets for Windows ☆

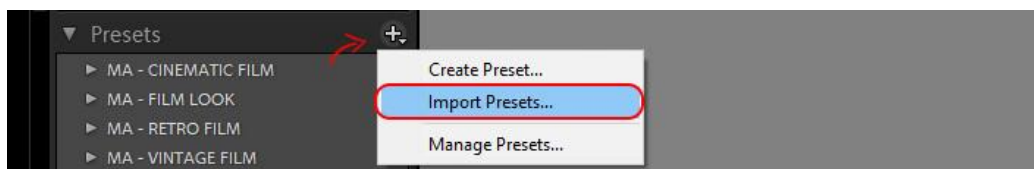
- 1- Open Lightroom
- 2- Go to: Edit • Preferences • Presets
- 3- Click on the box titled: Show Lightroom Presets Folder 4- Double click on Lightroom
- 5- Double click on Develop Presets
- 6- Copy the folder(s) of your presets into the Develop Presets folder
- 7- Restart Lightroom

☆ How To Install Lightroom 4, 5, 6 & CC 2017 Presets for Mac ☆

- 1- Open Lightroom
- 2- Go to: Lightroom (Dialogue) • Preferences • Presets

- 3- Click on the box titled: Show Presets Folder
- 4- Double click on Lightroom
- 5- Double click on Develop Presets
- 6- Copy the folder(s) of your presets into Develop Presets folder
- 7- Restart Lightroom

☆ FROM THE LIGHTROOM CLASSIC DEVELOP TAB ☆



1. Open Lightroom.
2. Go to the Develop Tab from the top most area of the window.
3. Locate the Presets panel at the left.
4. Click on the + button and select Import Presets
5. Select the MA presets you have downloaded.
6. They will now appear under their own category. If you can't locate them, please check under User Presets.
7. You can now use the presets on your photos.
