



Tutorial


01. Open up the project
02. Double click on the **“Place your image inside”** layer’s preview box



03. **Drag & drop** your image into this newly opened composition, **above the “Your image goes here”** layer
04. Scale your image all the way to the edges (optional)
05. Hit **Ctrl + S** to save – Don’t forget this step otherwise the image in the main composition will not be updated




06. **Go back** to main composition / project
07. Now turn on visibility of any **Triangle group (01 – 09)**, one group at a time
08. **(Optional)** You can also turn on any of the 4 **Background effects** or any of the 2 **Foreground effects**



Tips

Tip #01

You can turn off the triangle **fading effect** by holding **Shift** and **clicking** on the **Group's mask**



Tip #02

You can move the triangle's inner image freely. Just click and drag (Helpful when something isn't perfectly centered inside the triangle).

Tip #03

The same thing apply on transforming the image inside the triangle. Hit "**Ctrl + T**" and you can scale, rotate etc.

Tip #04

To modify foreground effects, first you'll need to **unlock** the layers by clicking on the lock icon next to them. Then you can change the opacity or blending modes etc.

Tip #05

If you'll decide to save this project with some image inside, that will make the project a lot bigger in size. Original project without image is $\pm 100\text{mb}$, with image it's $\pm 700\text{mb}$. I recommend leaving the original project as it is and you'll save some space.
