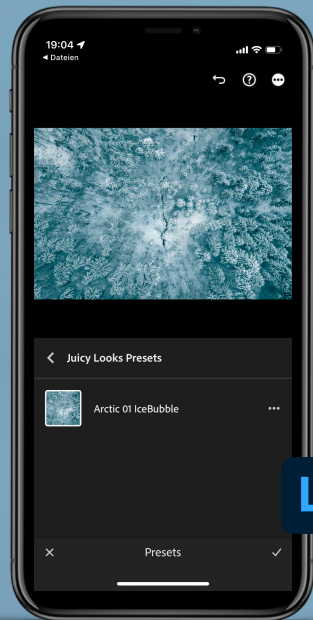

## Unpack the zip-file

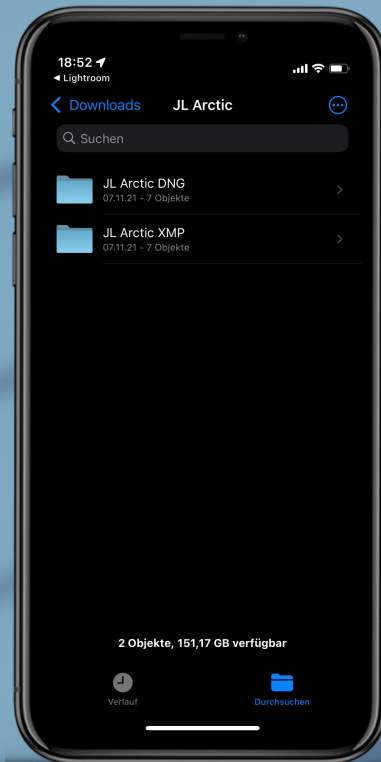
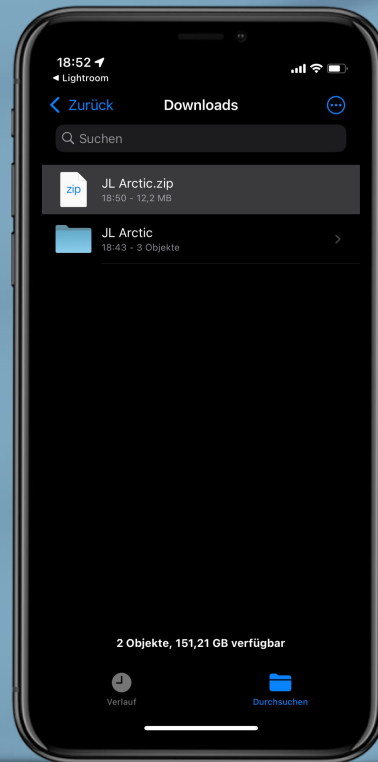
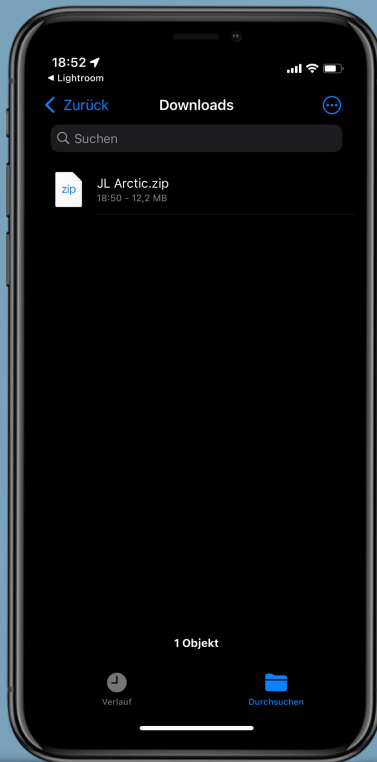
After download you can find a compressed **zip-file** in the 'download' section of your phone.

To uncompress, just tap on the zip-file and you will see the following folders.



**DNG = Lightroom Mobile App**

**XMP = Lightroom Desktop**



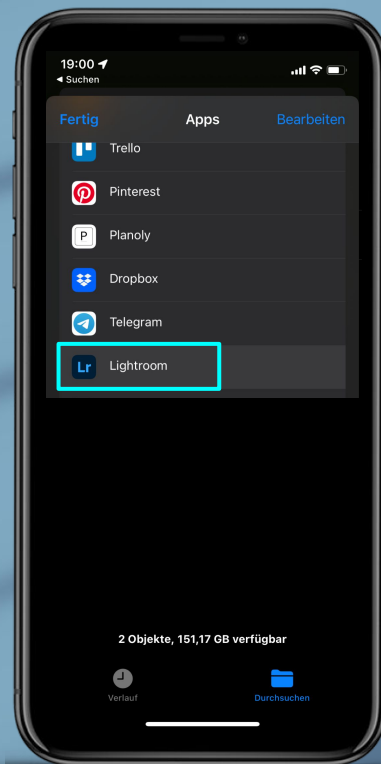
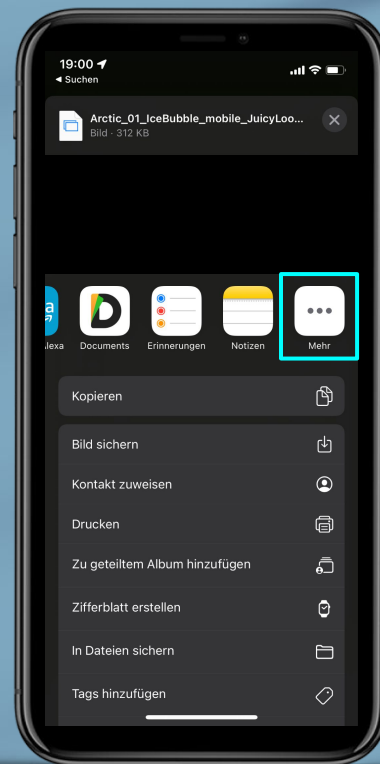
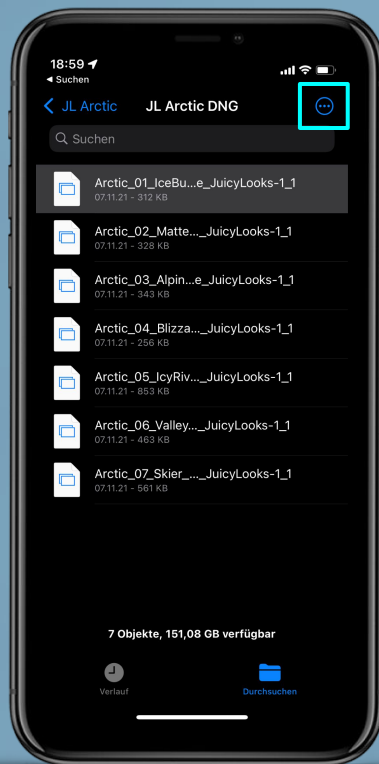

## Open DNG with LR App

I. Choose the DNG preset files and click on ⋮

II. Under 'more' you have to select the Lightroom Mobile App

III. Confirm and the app will open automatically

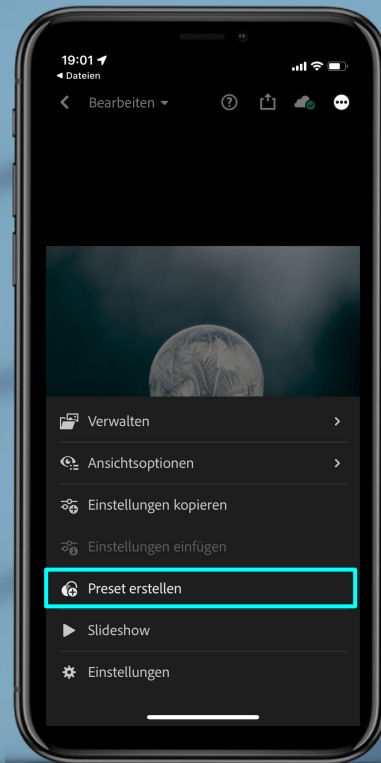
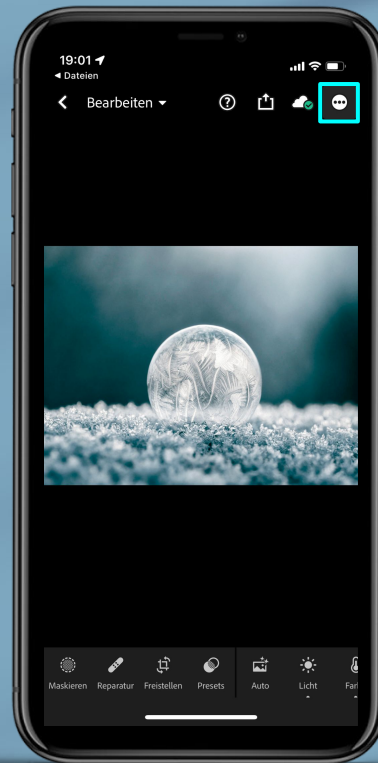
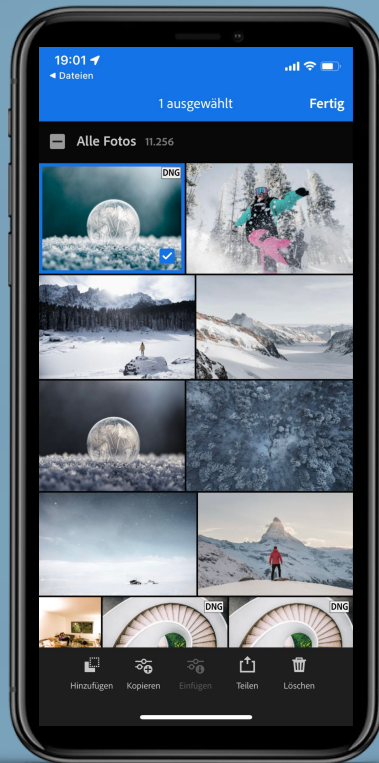

II. Tap  and 'Create Preset'



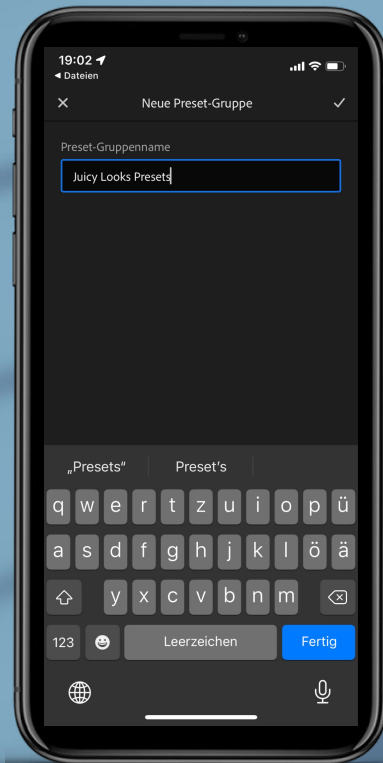
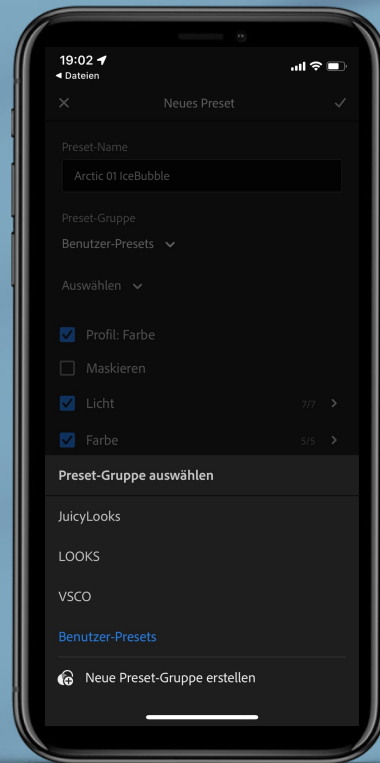
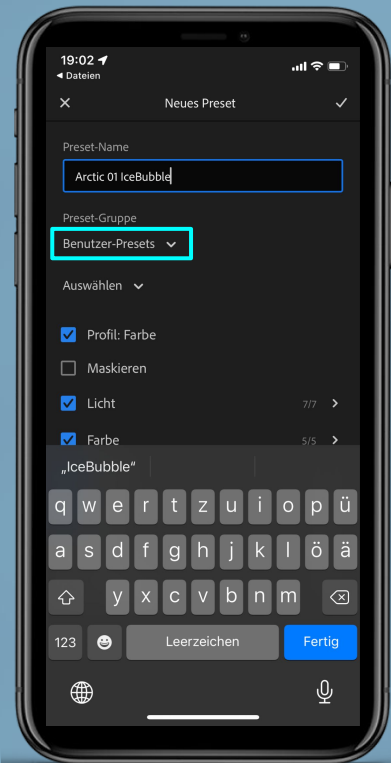

## Import your new presets

### I. In Lightroom

Go to the workspace **'Develop'**

II. On the left side under **'Presets'** click on **+** and choose **'Import Presets...'**

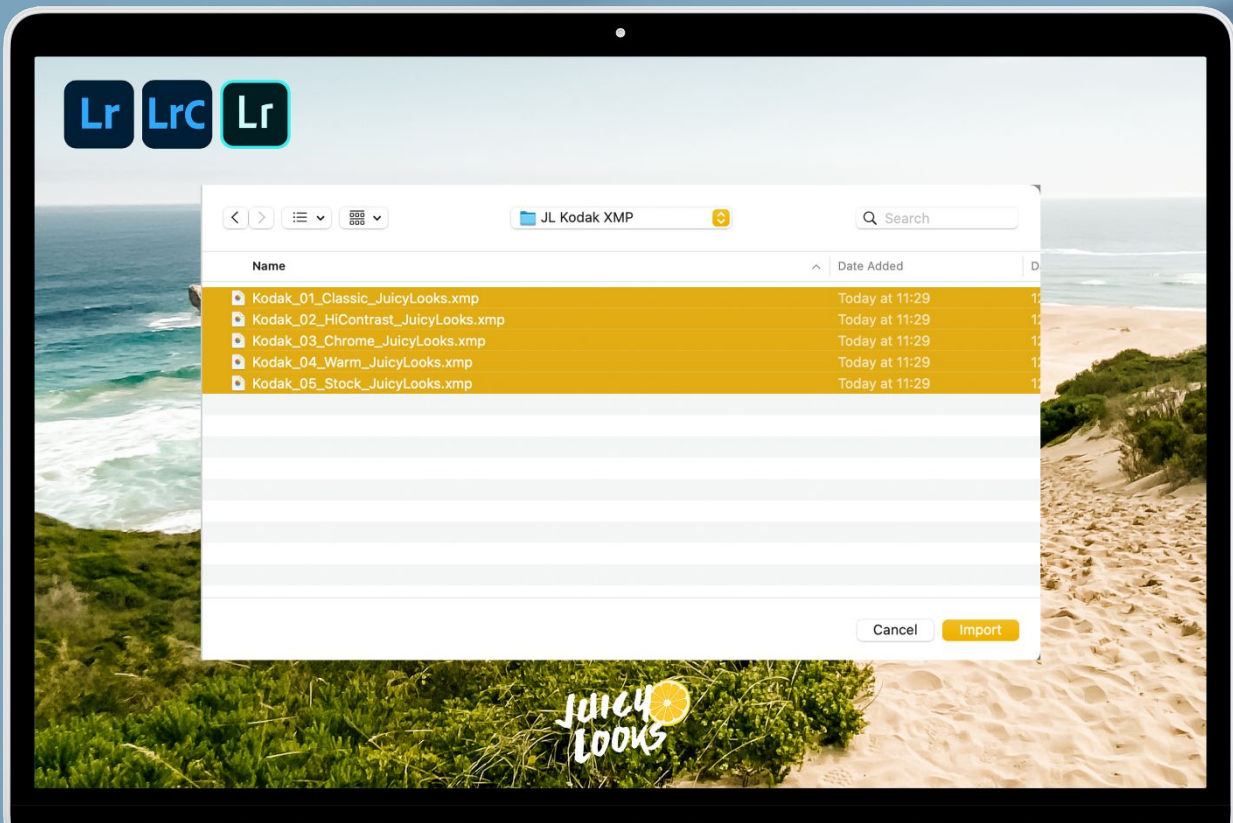

## Import the XMP Files

At first, you have to uncompress the downloaded zip-file.

Next, choose and import the **XMP Preset Files** into Lightroom

## Use your new presets!

On the left side you can see your new presets 🧙‍♂️

Just click through the presets and find a good match for your photo.

Adjust the parameter with the editing tools one right side to finetune the final look.

Tip: you can change the preset names at any time via right-click.
