






DOUBLE CLICK LAYER

TO INSERT IMAGE

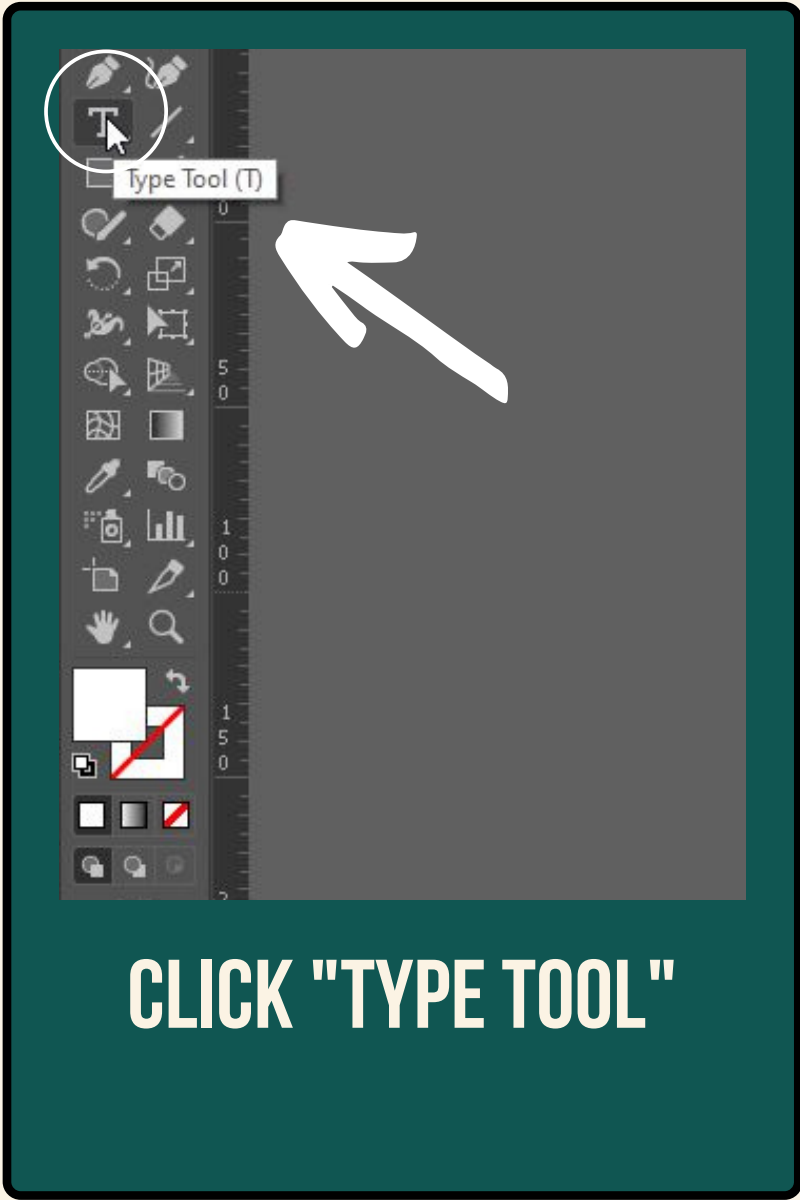


CLICK & DRAG TO ADJUST







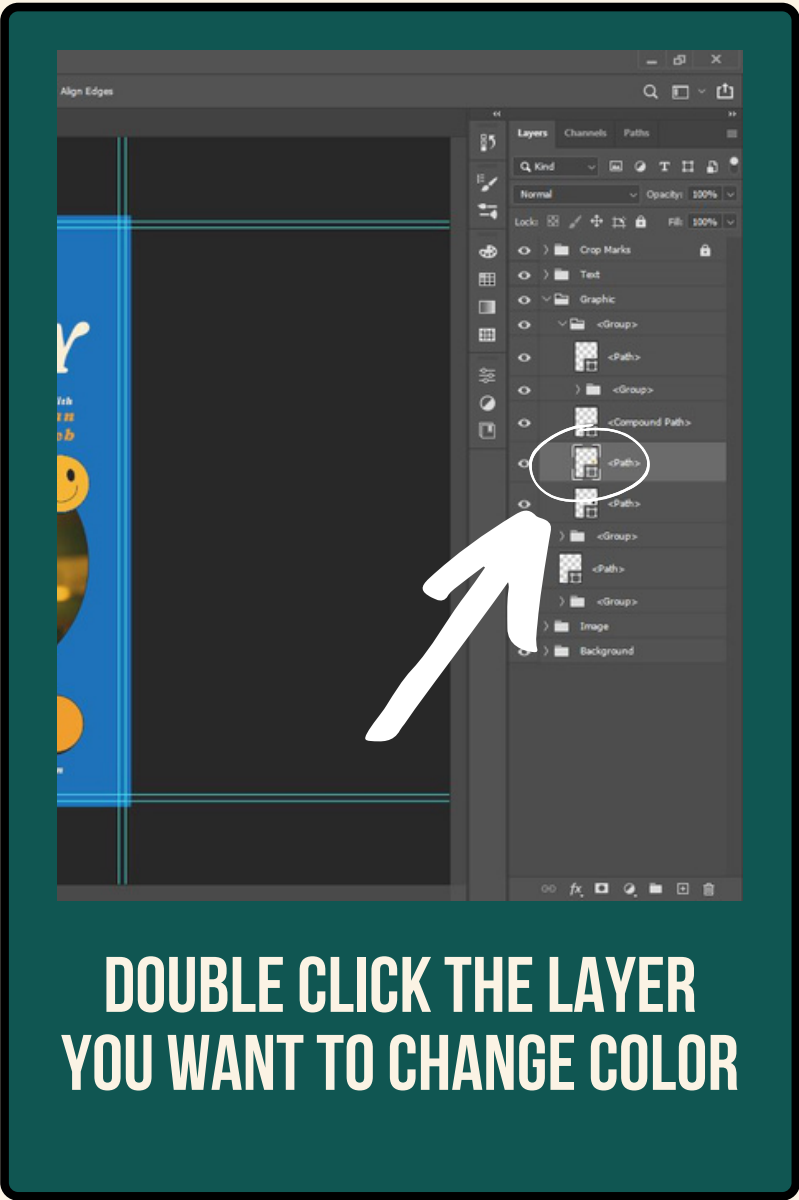


CLICK "COLOR PICKER" ON TOP SIDE PANEL

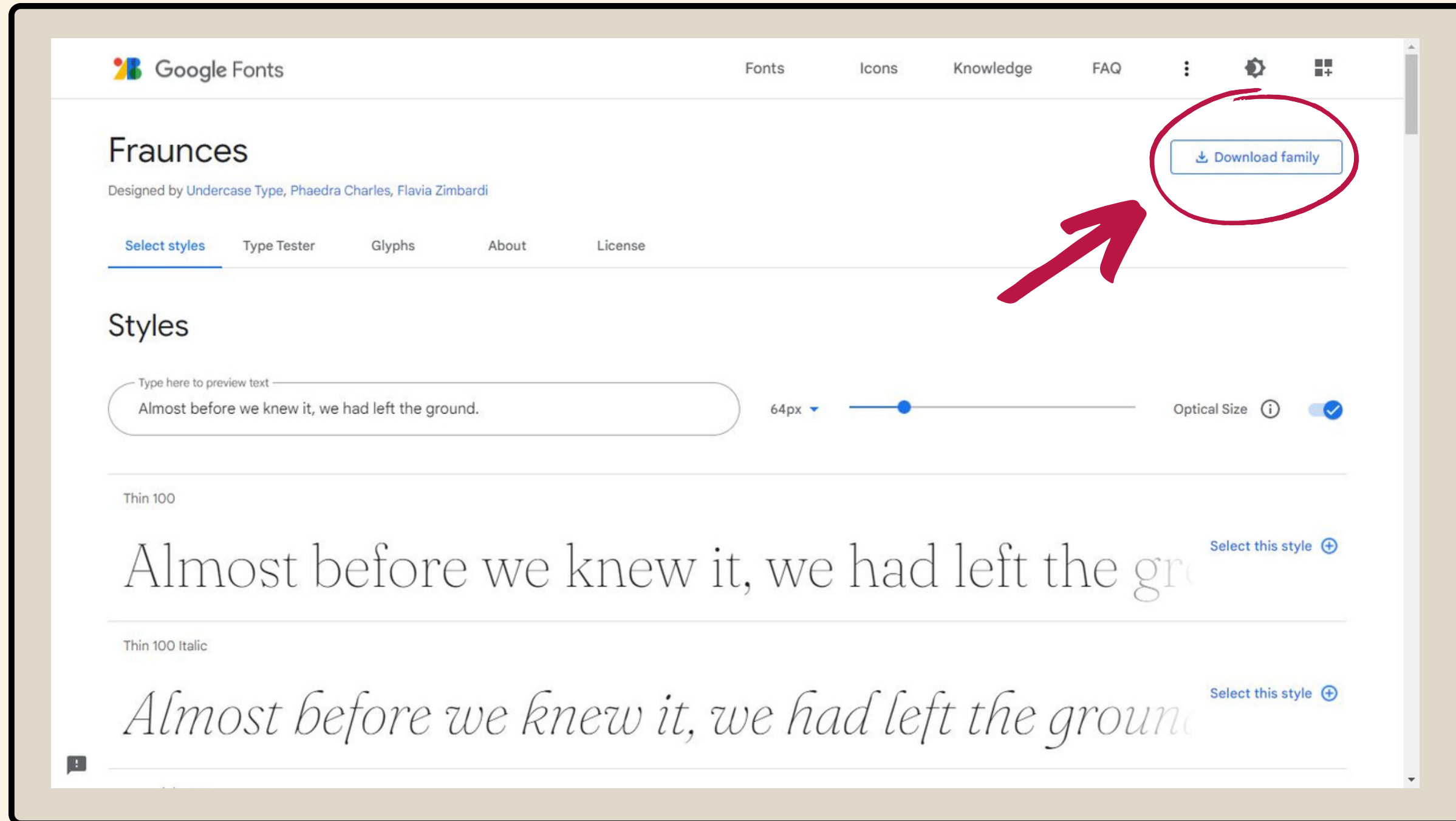
