

Here is a quick guide on how to install Lightroom Presets on desktop computers. Whether you use Lightroom on Mac or Windows.

LIGHTROOM CLASSIC CC (2018 AND NEWER)

STEP 1

Go to **Develop Module** (Shortcut D) and click the **plus sign** on the right side of the Presets panel

STEP 2

Select your presets **individually** or install a **zip file** that is easier and faster and then click Import.

LIGHTROOM CC

STEP 1

Inside Lightroom CC, go to **File > Import Profiles & Presets**.

STEP 2

Select the presets. Either import a **zip file** or select the presets and use shortcut CTRL/CMD+A to select all presets you want to add directly to Lightroom CC.

HOW TO INSTALL LIGHTROOM 4, 5, 6 & CC 2017 PRESETS FOR WINDOWS

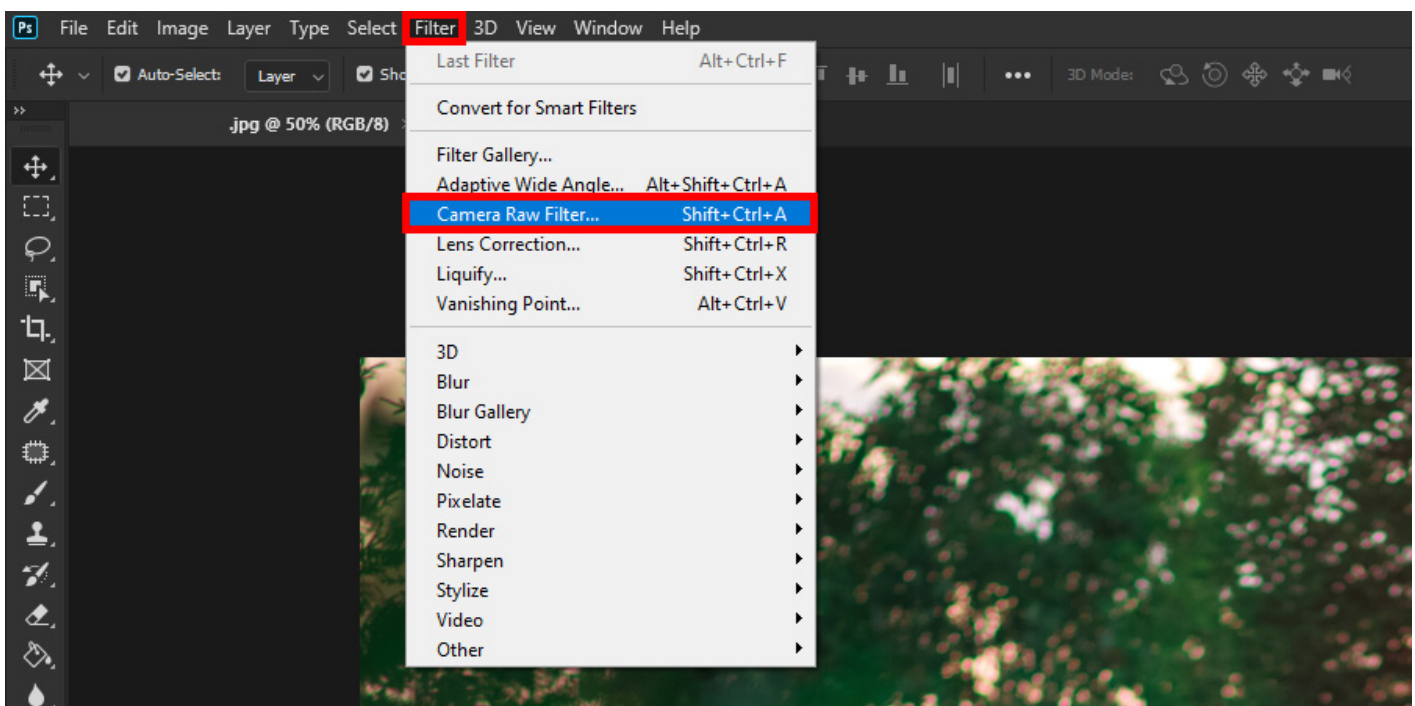
1. Open Lightroom
2. Go to: Edit • Preferences • Presets
3. Click on the box titled: **Show Lightroom Presets Folder**
4. Double click on Lightroom
5. Double click on Develop Presets
6. Copy the folder(s) of your presets into the **Develop Presets** folder
7. Restart Lightroom

HOW TO INSTALL LIGHTROOM 4, 5, 6 & CC 2017 PRESETS FOR MAC

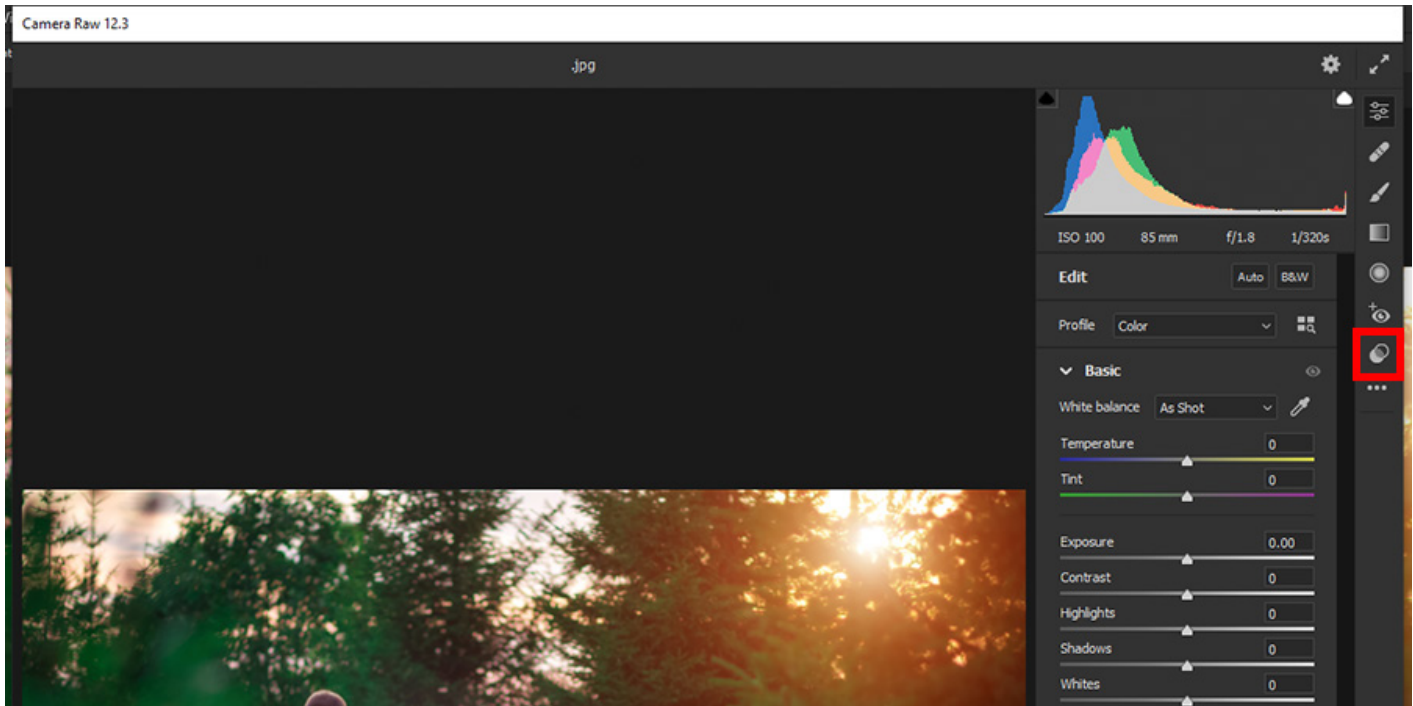
1. Open Lightroom
2. Go to: Lightroom (Dialogue) • Preferences • Presets
3. Click on the box titled: **Show Lightroom Presets Folder**
4. Double click on Lightroom
5. Double click on Develop Presets
6. Copy the folder(s) of your presets into **Develop Presets** folder
7. Restart Lightroom

How to install presets in Photoshop ACR

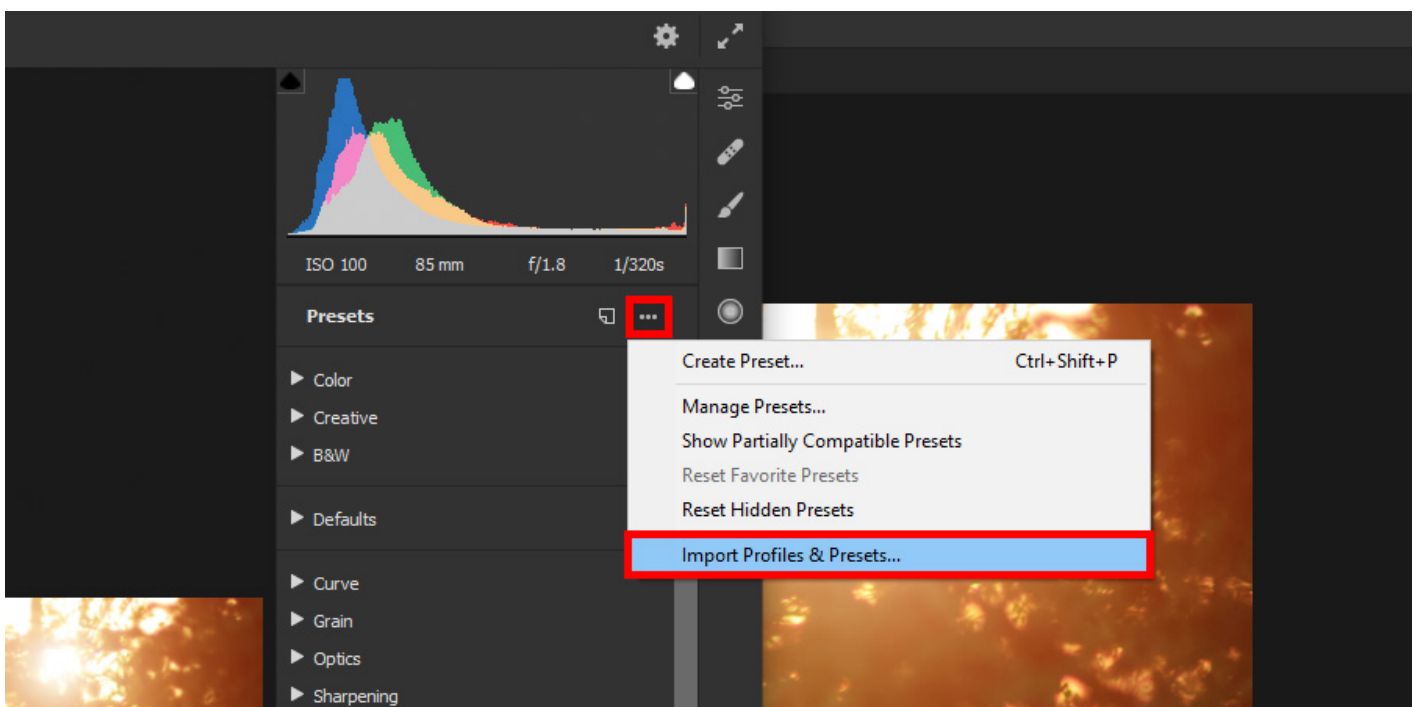
1. Download your presets in XMP format. These will download as a .zip file. (Do NOT unzip)
2. Launch Photoshop and open an image. (This image can be in JPEG or RAW format)
3. From the top menu, select "Filter" > "Camera Raw Filter..." to launch Camera Raw:



4. From the Camera Raw window, you can locate the "Presets" tab from the right toolbar. This appears as two overlapping circles:



5. From the Presets tab, open the "..." menu and select "Import Profiles & Presets...":



6. Select the entire .zip file(s) you downloaded (containing the XMP format presets) and select "Open" to import. Once populated, they should appear in their organized folders underneath that "Presets" header.

7. To Use Your New Presets: Simply expand the newly imported presets folder (via the little arrow to the left), select a preset or hover over to view multiple options, and click to apply your desired edit. Click "OK" at the bottom of your Camera Raw window to continue editing your image in Photoshop.

Alternative Manual Installation:

For this method you will download the XMP format presets from your downloads page. These will download as a compressed .zip file. You will simply unzip/extract those .XMP preset files for a quick copy-and-paste into your Adobe Camera Raw Settings folder.

To locate the Camera Raw Settings folder:

Find the following location on your computer hard drive:

Mac Users: Users>YOUR NAME>Library>Application Support>Adobe>Camera Raw> Settings

Windows Users: Application Data>Adobe>Camera Raw>Settings OR C: Users-[user name]>AppData>Roaming>Adobe>Camera Raw>Settings

Copy and paste the .xmp presets into the Settings Folder.

Windows Users: If you are unable to find your Settings Folder, you will need to change your folder options to show hidden files and folders. See instructions [here](#)

Mac Users: If you are unable to find your Library Folder, see [this article](#)

Mac Users: If you are unable to find the Settings Folder follow the steps below:

Go to your Finder and select Go > Go to Folder from the drop-down menu. Copy and paste the following in the search box: ~/Library/Application Support/Adobe/Camera Raw/Settings
