



HOW TO INSTALL PRESETS in Adobe Lightroom Classic

1. Open Lightroom Classic and select the photo you want to *apply* the preset to.
2. Go to the *Develop* module.
3. Click on the *Presets* panel.
4. There are two ways to *import* presets in Lightroom Classic:
 - Import presets from a *folder*: Click on the Import Presets button and browse to the folder where you saved the preset file. Click on the Open button to import the preset.
 - Import presets from a Lightroom *preset pack*: Click on the Presets panel dropdown menu and select Get More Presets. This will open the Lightroom Presets Manager. Click on the Catalog tab and browse to the preset pack you want to install. Now click on the Install button to install the preset pack.
5. The preset will be *imported* into Lightroom Classic.
6. Select the preset you want to *apply* to your photo.
7. Click on the *Apply* button.

Your photo will now be *transformed* with the preset that you selected.

You can *adjust* the settings of the preset to fine-tune the look of your photo.
