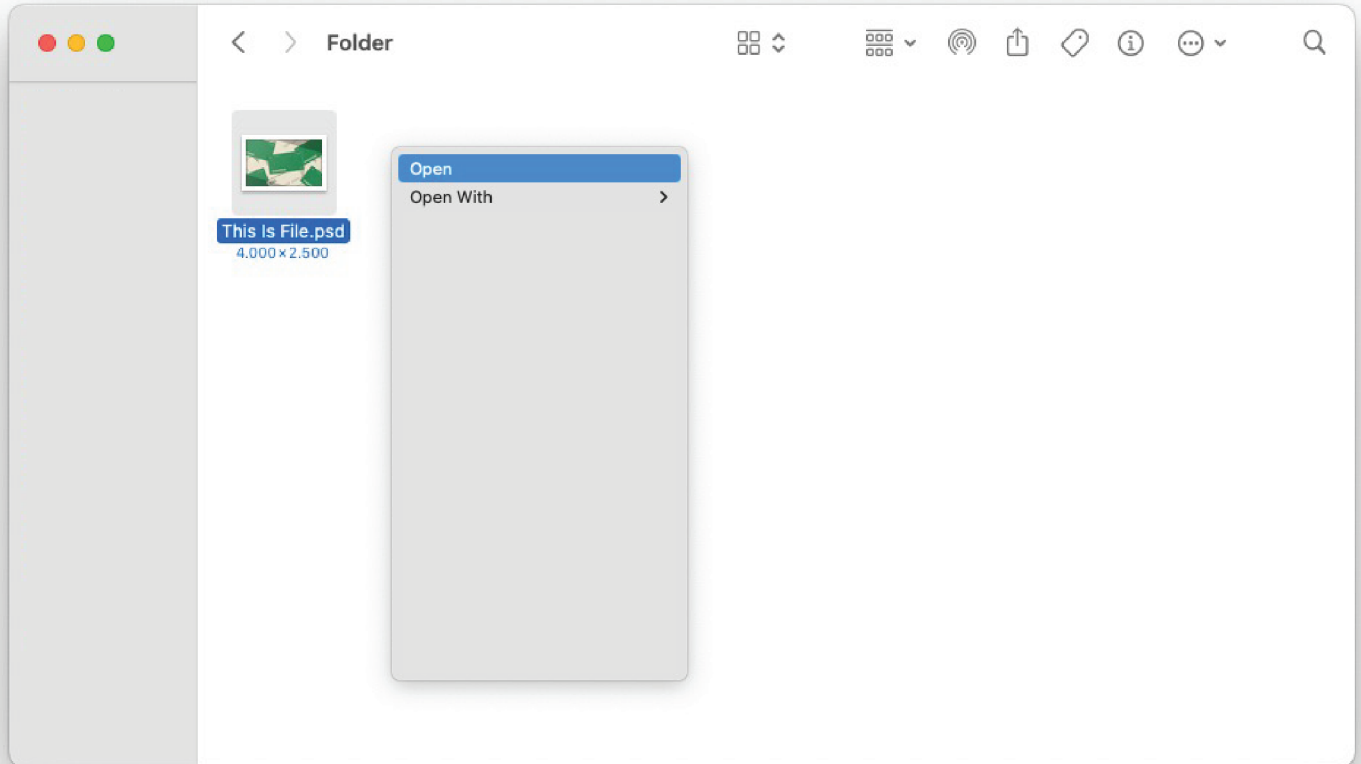

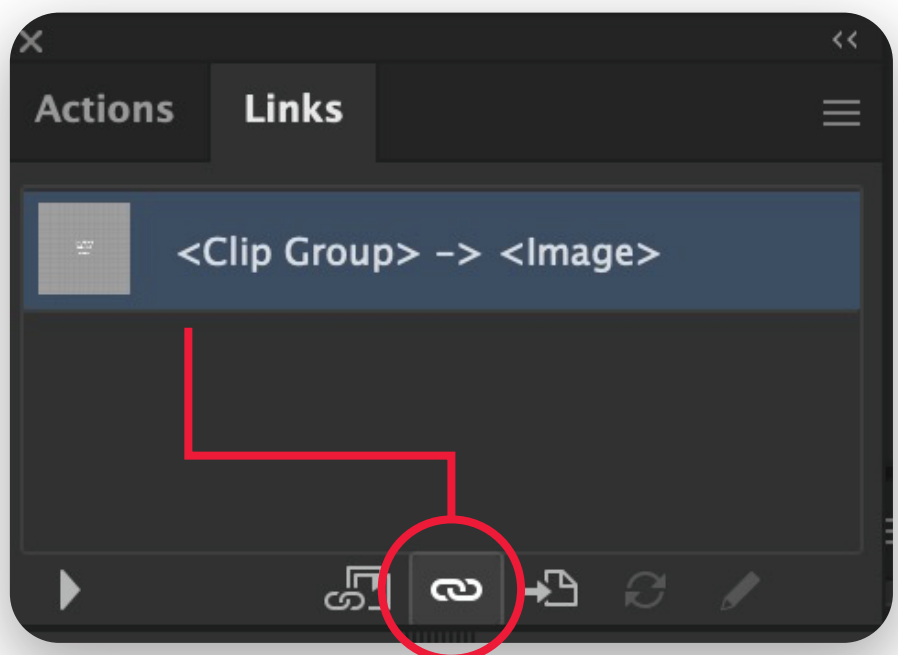
## Step 1

Open the file as usual.



## Step 2

Click Window > Links to show the Links tab. There's a replaceable image on the tab, to change it click the placeholder on the tab and then click the chain icons. Choose your image to replace. Adjust your image and make sure to fill the placeholder nicely.



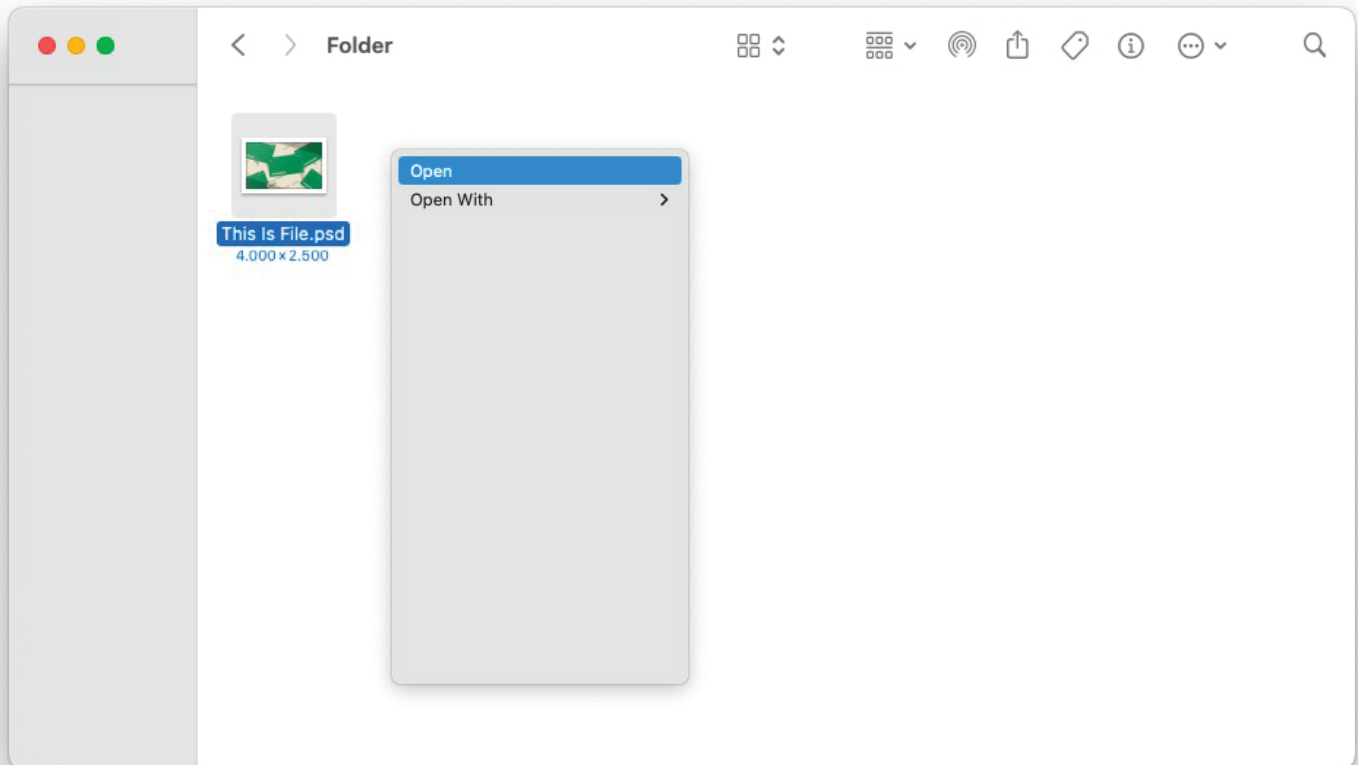

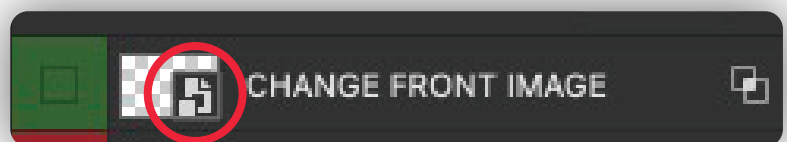
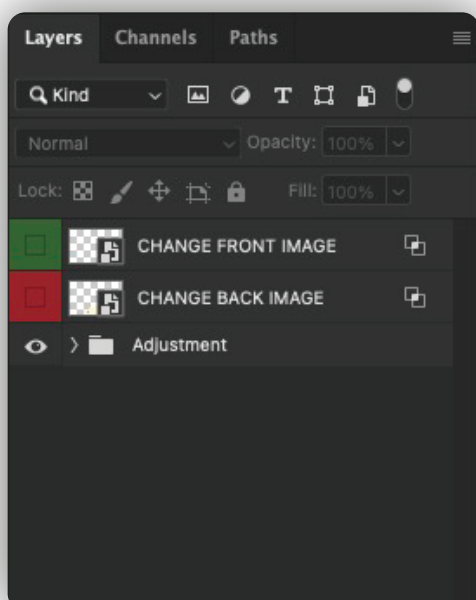
## Step 1

Open the file as usual.



## Step 2

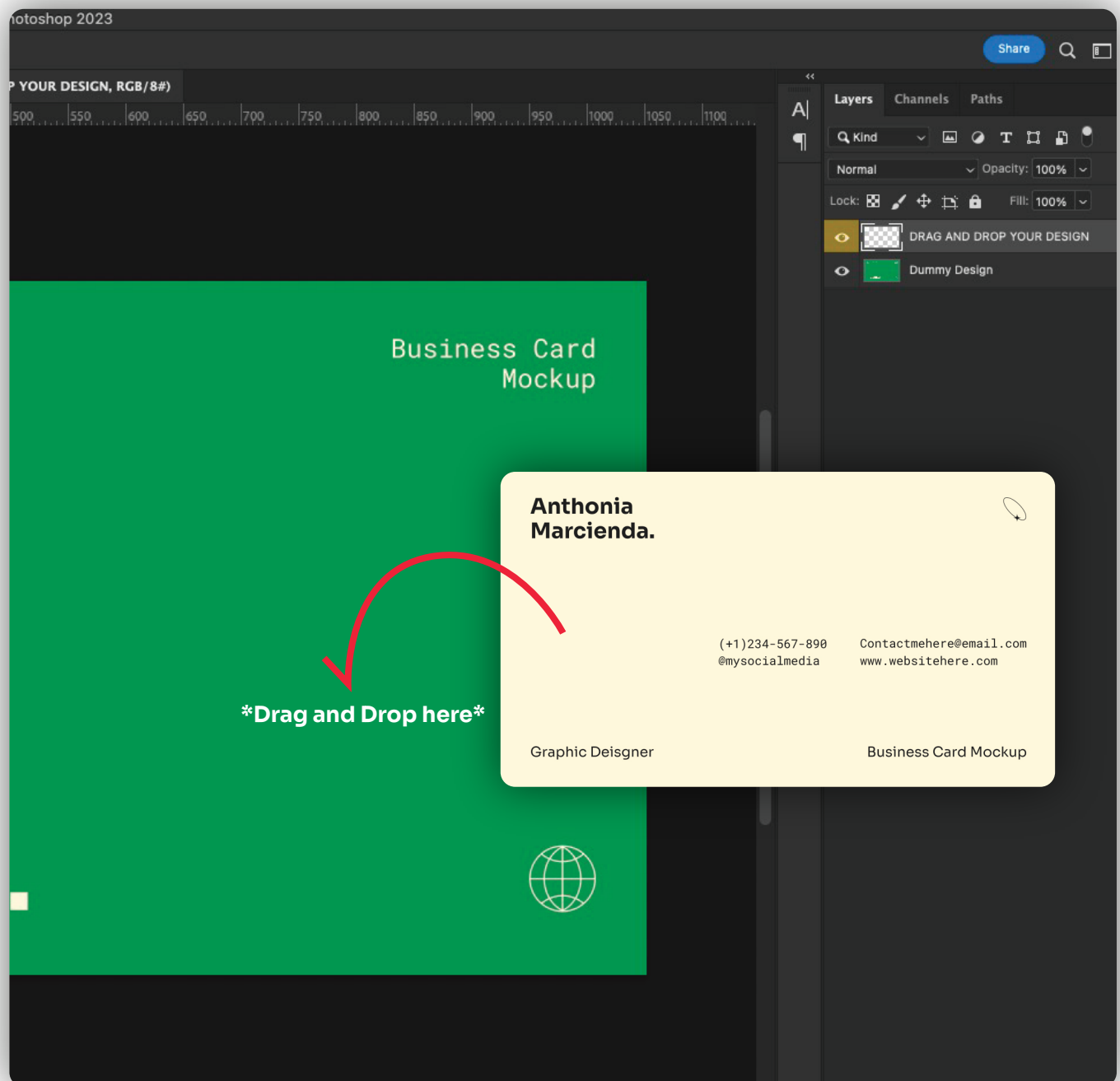
Inside the file there are colored layer as an image placeholder



Double click this icon to open the smart object and you will directed to another tab

## Step 3

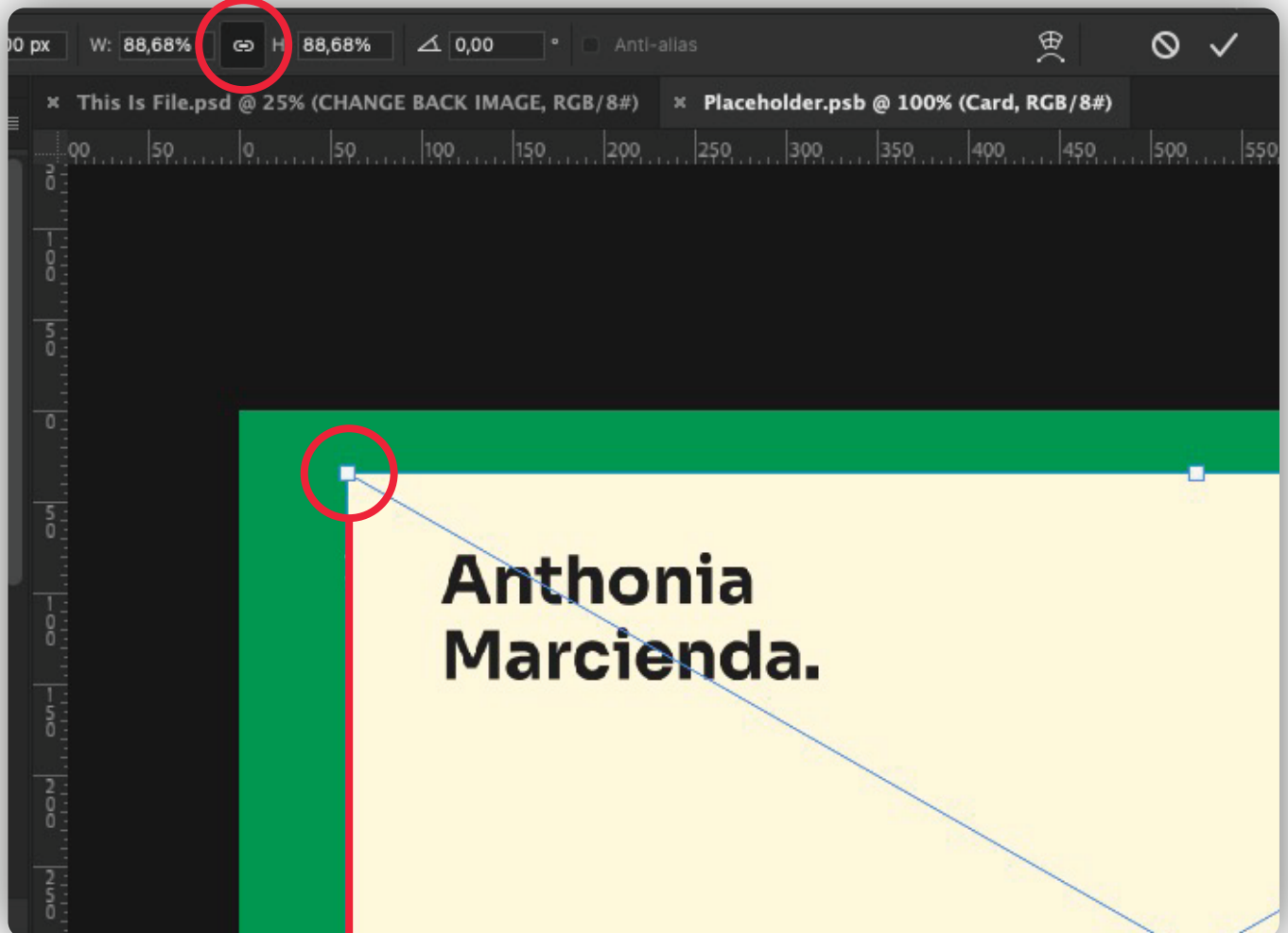
After the placeholder opened, you will see the Drag and Drop layer.  
Simply select the layer and then drag and drop your image on the artboard.



## Step 4

If your image doesn't fit the artboard, adjust the size by simply dragging the corner of the image until it fill the artboard.

\*Make sure the chain symbol active to keep the image ratio



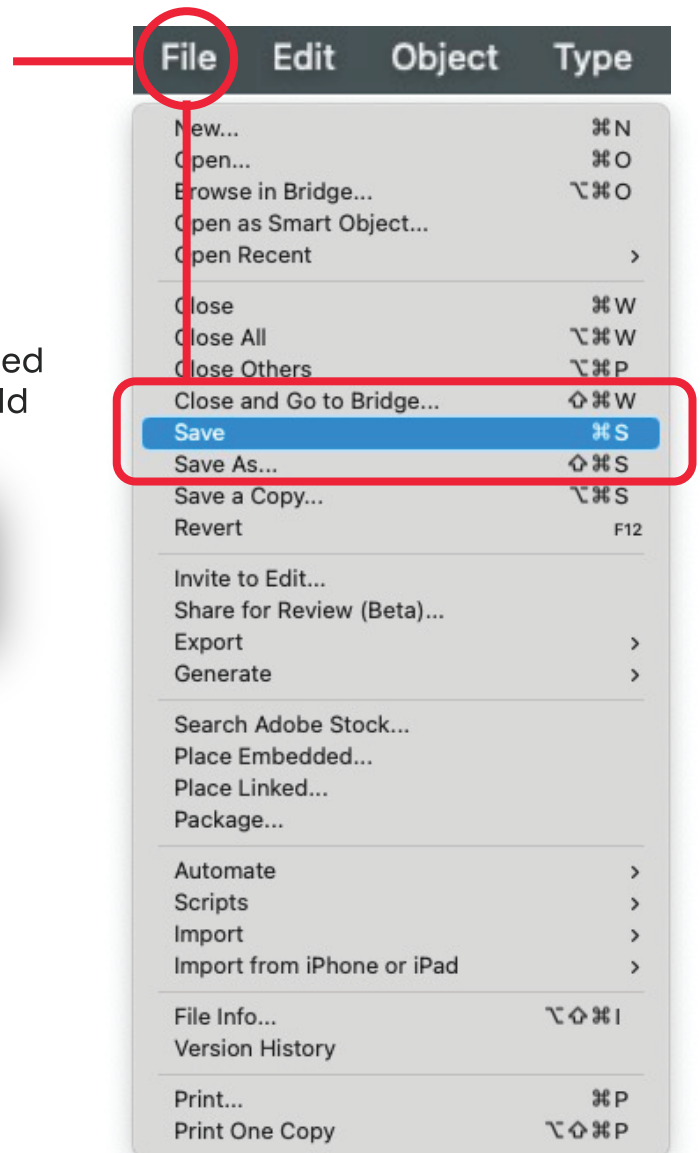
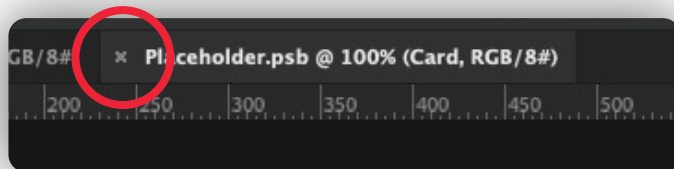
You can drag the corner like this to resize the image, after that you can hit **Enter** to apply the size

## Step 4

Save the placeholder by clicking the File > Save or simply pressing Ctrl+S (Windows) or Cmd+S (Mac Os)

## Step 5

Close the current tab and you will be directed to the previous file tab. Your image should appear on the mockup now.
