

Step By Step.

REPLACE IMAGE
ON ADOBE ILLUSTRATOR.


STEP 1

First, you need to open the graphic template files.



STEP 2

Now, click the link tab by clicking Window > Links. You can replace the image on the tab by clicking the place holder and then click the chain icons. Choose the image you want to replace and then fill the place holder with your image and make it look good.






STEP 1

Like the previous one, you need to open the graphic template files.



STEP 2


There are layer with the name (Image) in the files with a placeholder for images inside the layer. When you double click the fold paper icon, you'll be taken to a new tab where you can interact with the smart object.



STEP 3

Don't forget to Delete the Layer that we point with a red arrow marker.


Now drag your image onto the artboard after you've selected the layer.



STEP 4


If your image doesn't fit the artboard, just drag a the corner until it fill the board.

And, make sure the chain symbol is active to keep the image ratio.




STEP 5

The place holder can be saved by clicking the File > Save or by pressing Ctrl + S (Windows) or Cmd + S (Mac)



STEP 6

Now you can close the current tab and you'll be taken back to the previous file tab. Your image should show up on the mockup and ready to go.
