

Installing Lightroom presets can be done in a few steps, and the process varies slightly depending on whether you're using **Lightroom Classic** or the **Adobe Lightroom CC (Cloud)** version. Here's a guide for both:

For Lightroom Classic (Desktop):

1. **Download the Presets:**
 - Presets usually come in .xmp format or a compressed .zip folder. Extract the presets if they're in a .zip file.
 2. **Open Lightroom Classic:**
 - Launch **Lightroom Classic** on your desktop.
 3. **Navigate to the Develop Module:**
 - On the top right, click on the **Develop** module.
 4. **Import the Presets:**
 - In the **Presets** panel on the left, click the small + icon at the top of the panel.
 - Choose **Import Presets** from the drop-down menu.
 - Browse to the folder where you downloaded or extracted your .xmp presets, and select the files. Then click **Import**.
 5. **Use Your Presets:**
 - The presets will now appear in the **Presets** panel in the left sidebar of the **Develop** module. You can apply them to any image by simply clicking on the preset name.
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For Adobe Lightroom CC (Cloud):

1. **Download the Presets:**
 - Like in Lightroom Classic, presets may come in .xmp format or as .zip files. Extract them if needed.
2. **Open Adobe Lightroom CC:**
 - Launch the cloud-based Lightroom app on your desktop or mobile device.
3. **Go to Edit Panel:**
 - Select any photo, and open the **Edit** panel by clicking the **three sliders icon** on the top right.
4. **Import Presets:**
 - At the bottom of the panel, click the **Presets** button (three overlapping circles).
 - Then, click the **three dots icon (...)** at the top of the Presets menu.
 - Choose **Import Presets** from the options.
 - Browse to your downloaded or extracted .xmp files and select them. Click **Import**.
5. **Use Your Presets:**
 - Your imported presets will now appear under the **Presets** panel. Apply them by clicking on the preset while editing a photo.
