Simple Guide: How to Use the Mockup in Photoshop

Step-by-Step Instructions to Change the Smart Object

Open the Mockup File:

Launch Adobe Photoshop.

Open the mockup file you have downloaded by going to File > Open and selecting the mockup file.

Locate the Smart Object Layer:

In the Layers panel, look for the layer that contains the Smart Object. This layer is usually named something like "<< Your Design Here" or "<< Replace Me".

The Smart Object layer is indicated by a small icon at the bottom right corner of the layer thumbnail.

Edit the Smart Object:

Double-click on the Smart Object layer thumbnail. This action will open the Smart Object in a new window.

In the new window, you will see the current placeholder design. Replace this with your own design by either dragging and dropping your design into this window or by going to File > Place Embedded and selecting your design file.

Adjust Your Design:

Resize and position your design within the Smart Object window to fit as desired. Use the Transform tool (Ctrl+T or Cmd+T) to adjust the size and rotation if needed.

Ensure your design covers the entire canvas area to avoid any unwanted borders.

Save and Close the Smart Object:

Once you are satisfied with how your design looks, save the changes by going to File > Save or simply press Ctrl+S (Windows) or Cmd+S (Mac).

Close the Smart Object window by clicking the X in the top right corner or by pressing Ctrl+W (Windows) or Cmd+W (Mac).

View Your Design in the Mockup:

You will now see your design applied to the mockup in the original Photoshop window. The mockup will automatically update with your new design.

Adjust the Mockup (Optional):

If needed, you can further adjust the mockup by editing other layers, such as shadows, background colors, or other effects to better suit your design presentation.

Save Your Final Mockup:

Save your completed mockup by going to File > Save As and choosing your desired file format (e.g., JPEG, PNG, PSD).
